CURRENT TRADE CONDITIONS.

ONTARIO.

The closing days of August finds the
white pine market almost as strong as it
was one month ago. The constant
operation of the mills has necessarily
increased the yard stocks, but shipping
has been so active that the accumulation
at the mills is not large. Nearly all
manufacturers report a larger volume of
business than last year. There has been
a steady enquiry for all grades of pine,
but particularly for the better qualities
and 10 and 12 inch boards, of which the
supply is very light. Buyers from the
United States have been an important
factor in the market this year, and have
bought extensively in the Ottawa Valley
and Georgian Bay districts. If there is
any weakening of prices it pertains
exclusively to one or two of the lower
grades. The future of pine lumber prices
depends very largely upon the policy
which manufacturers follow during the
coming winter in respect to their logging
operations. If a moderate cut only is
made, there is no question that present
prices will be maintained. The conditions
seem to favor light operations in the
woods, as the cost of labor and supplies is
exceptionally high. While the outlook for
hardwood lumber is fair, the actual
demand is less than might reasonably be
expected. There is, however, a firm
undertone to the market, and it may be
that the prospective improvement may
come earlier than is anticipated. Lath
and shingles continue in light supply, with
a good demand, and prices are quite firm.

QUEBEC AND NEW BRUNSWICK

Quite a number of vessels have loaded
along the St. Lawrence for the United
Kingdom. The market for spruce is
looking a little more hopeful, and the

opinion is freely expressed that operations
in the woods will be curtailed the coming
winter, and that next season will witness
a marked improvement in spruce prices.
The shipments from New Brunswick and
Nova Scotia to Great Britain have been
light of late, but increased exports have
been made to South America and France.
The latter country is expected to be a
considerable buyer of Canadian lumber
within the next few years. Cedar shingles
are firmer, practically no extras being
offered at less than \$3.00 on Boston rate
of freight. Clears are selling at \$2.70
and second clears at \$2.25.

UNITED STATES

The report presented at the semi-annual
meeting of the Mississippi Valley Lumber-
men's Association makes the very satis-
factory showing that stocks on hand are
decreasing each year, while the ship-
ments are showing a corresponding in-
crease. This statement has in a measure
dispelled any hope which buyers may
have had of obtaining lower prices this
fall. The white pine market is exception-
ally strong, the large mills having either
sold ahead or are meeting with a demand
for the lumber as fast as it is cut. The
effect of the two unfavorable factors,
namely, the corn crop failure and the
strike of steel workers, has passed off,
and indications are promising for a brisk
fall trade. The higher grades of lumber
are wanted in excess of the supply, while
the common and lower grades are moving
liberally at good prices. In Chicago
there is a pronounced scarcity of No. 1
and No. 2 12-inch boards as well as piece
stuff, which ranges from \$2.75 to \$3.00 in
cargo lots. Norway pine is not as firm
as white pine. Our Albany and Buffalo
price lists this week show an advance in
the higher grades of pine. Reports from
these cities talk of a very firm market for
uppers and selects. Spruce lumber is also
hardening, there being a good demand
for building material in New York. The
hardwood trade still lacks the snap which
is shown by pine, although some dealers
give a more satisfactory account of trade
and report heavy shipments of basswood,
maple and quartered oak. Lath and
shingles are not accumulating to any
extent, and it is almost certain that the
present prices will be sustained through-
out the fall.

GREAT BRITAIN.

The course of the British timber mar-
ket week after week has been so similar
as to make a review much of a repetition.
The market is still heavy, but with some
strong spots. The low price of lumber is
stimulating consumption, and there has

been considerable buying of building materials. At recent auction sales prices have been further depressed, especially floorings, scantlings and the lower grades of lumber generally. At a London sale 3x14-24 inch white pine from Quebec brought only £15 9s. per standard. The stock, however, was of poor quality. Spruce prices have not undergone any further advance, but dealers are optimistic that if the fall receipts are not too heavy an upward trend will set in. It is announced that Norwegian shippers contemplate carrying over their summer and autumn production until next spring. Waney board pine has of late shown strength, and Quebec oak of good quality is scarce. Specifications suitable for railway requirements meet with quick sale at firm figures. Red pine is weak, and no improvement can be reported in New Brunswick birch planks.

STOCKS AND PRICES.

The steamer Briarlene is about to load a cargo of deals at Tusket Wedge, N.S., for France.

The steamer Adato cleared last week from Victoria, B.C., for Taku, with a cargo of 2,698,000 ft. of lumber.

As a result of low water in the Gattineau river 150,000 saw logs were stranded along the upper reaches of the river.

The Eastern Lumber Company, of Albany, N. Y., have purchased 7,000,000 feet of lumber from the Northrop Lumber Company, of John's Island, Ont.

Vigars & Company, of Port Arthur, Ont., have finished their season's cut. They report an active trade, in addition to the large contract for supplying timber for railroad and bridge construction.

In the Saginaw Valley log run lumber is quoted at \$18 to \$21, box at \$14 to \$15, and mill culls at \$12. The Norway cut ranges from \$14 up, according to dimensions.

The steamer Daventry sailed last week from Montreal for Newcastle with a full cargo of deals. The steamer Verbeia cleared last week for Valencia via Three Rivers with deals, and the barque Poseidon sailed for Waterford with deals.

Spruce lath is selling in New York at \$2.50 to \$2.60. In Chicago white pine is quoted at \$3.25, and No. 1 mixed at \$2.75. In the Saginaw Valley 18 inch XXXX pine shingles are held at \$3.75 and clear butts at \$2.50; 16-inch at \$3.25.

N. & A. Dymont, of Thessalon, Ont., are reported to have sold timber limit No. 16S, in the Algoma district, to Moore & Macdonald, for the sum of \$105,000. The limit was purchased by Messrs

Dymont about three years ago for a sum in the neighborhood of \$20,000.

The manufacturers of hemlock in Pennsylvania put into effect a new price list on August 15th, making an advance of 50 cents a thousand. According to the new list, bill timber will range from \$15 for 12, 14 and 16 feet to \$20.50 for 38 and 40 feet; 2x4 to 3x12, 12, 14 and 16 feet, will be quoted at \$14.50.

The schooner John B. Coyle sailed last week from Yarmouth, N.S., for Rosalia, with 657,000 ft. of spruce lumber and scantling, furnished by Parker, Eakins & Company and D. A. & D. R. Saunders. The barque Eberia sailed from same port for Buenos Ayres, with 768,000 ft. of lumber and scantling. The barques Albertina and Argentina are loading at Yarmouth for Buenos Ayres, and the barque Reform at Tusket Wedge for Buenos Ayres.

FIRES.

The box factory of Holmes & Aspin and the sash and door factory of D. Gagne & Co. in Montreal, were destroyed by fire last week. The loss in each case is about \$4,000.

The saw mill of the Northern Lumber Company at Garland, Man., which was burned last week, was valued at \$8,000, three-quarters of which is covered by insurance. T. A. Burrows, M.P.P., of Winnipeg, is president of the company.

The Harrison River Timber & Trading Co.'s saw mill at Harrison River, B.C., was burned recently at a loss of \$12,000. Fulbrook & McKim's mill at same place suffered a small loss.

The planing mill of Robert Stewart at Guelph, Ont., was damaged by fire on August 17th to the extent of \$4,000.

The saw mill of E. Esilets at Three Rivers, Que., has been burned, loss \$10,000.

BUSINESS NOTES.

Chestnut & Son and Tabor & O'Neill, wood-working factory and sash and door factory, have amalgamated.

A receiver is announced to have been appointed for the Muskoka Lumber Company, of North Tonawanda, N. Y.

Malone's Three Rivers Hay, Produce and Lumber Company, of Three Rivers, Que., has been dissolved.

THE BOSTON MARKET.

The spruce lumber market at Boston continues firm, although business is not particularly active. Nothing in spruce frames is being sold below \$18, and from that figure up to \$20 and even more is being obtained. Merchantable boards are worth \$15.50 to \$17, and matched boards, \$17 to \$17.50. Laths are quiet and steady at \$2.90 to \$2.85 for 1-5-8 in. and \$2.70 for 1-2 in.

Eastern cedar shingles are firmer for extras, for the reason that the trade has turned to them, under the fact that they are only about 25c. higher than clears, when the acknowledged difference is 50c. Dealers find that they are getting a good demand for extras, with most of the manufacturers declining to ship them for less than \$3 to Boston. Most of the dealers ask \$3 for extras; clears, \$2.60 to \$2.70; second clear \$2.15 to \$2.25; sap, \$2; extra No. 1, \$1.60 to \$1.75; Washington and British Columbia, 16-inch, five butts to 2 inches.

Hardwood lumber continues in only fair request: One inch. whitewood, \$38 to \$40; thicker, \$26 to \$43; 3/4 inch, \$30 to \$31; saps, inch, \$25 to \$30; common, \$23 to \$25; quartered oak, \$65 to \$70; fancy, \$80 to \$90; plain oak, \$35 to \$45; ash, \$38 to \$45; cherry, \$50 to \$130; maple, \$30 to \$40; sycamore, quartered inch, \$40 to \$50; walnut, \$100 to \$130.

Clapboards are scarce, with the market largely nominal: Extra spruce, \$30 to \$34, clear, \$28 to \$30, second clear, \$25 to \$27; extra No. 1, \$18 to \$20; pine, extra, \$36 to \$38; clear, \$36 to \$37; second clear, \$28 to \$39.

From the provinces last week five cargoes of lumber were received, with a total of 1,742,400 feet, 66,000 feet of piling and 10,000 railway ties.
