At a Meeting of the Principals of the Town of York and its Vicinity, held on the 15th day of December, 1791. The Honorable Committee of the Town of York, do hereby resolve, that it is Resolved,

- 1st.—THAT a select Society be established by an Act of the Town of York, called THE LOYAL AND PATRIOTIC SOCIETY, for the following specific purposes:
  - 1<sup>st</sup>.—To afford aid and relief to such Families of the Town of York, who appear to experience particular Distress in consequence of the War, and whose Friends and Relations employed in the Militia.
  - 2<sup>d</sup>.—To afford like aid and relief to such Militiamen of the Town of York, who are wounded in the War, by Wounds or otherwise, in consequence of the War, and to the Committee hereafter to be named, to be appointed by the Town Council, or the Legislature, to some of the cases above mentioned.
  - 3<sup>d</sup>.—To reward Merit, excite Emulation, and confer Medals or other honorary marks of public Acknowledgment, on such Instances of personal Courage or Fidelity in the Service of His Majesty's Regular or Militia Forces.
  - 4<sup>d</sup>.—THAT that the Society shall continue during the War, and shall be under the special protection of the Town of SHEAFFE, or the Person Administering the same, during the time being.
  - 5<sup>d</sup>.—THAT every Person throughout the Province of the Town of York, who shall contribute One Pound or upwards, shall be admitted a Member of the Society, and have the privilege of recommending and voting at all General Meetings and Deliberations of the Society, of His Majesty's Executive and Legislative Council, the Speaker of the House of Assembly, the Clergy, or any other Person whose annual Subscription shall be not less than One Pound. The Directors of the Society for the purpose of the above mentioned Field Officers of His Majesty's Regular Forces, and of the Honorary Members of the Society.
  - 6<sup>th</sup>.—THAT the affairs of the Society be Governed by a Board of Directors to assemble Quarterly, that the Board be of the Town of York, which Board shall consist of a Mayor, or any number, not less than five of the Members of His Majesty's Executive Council.

8th.—AND whereas it is the opinion of this Society, that no Reward or Service, can compensate for insubordination and breach of Duty, and has been particularly Resolved, That the Board of Directors shall not confer any other Honorary marks of Distinction upon any Militiaman who is guilty of Desertion or absenting himself from his Duty without leave, or to afford any Relief whatever from the Funds of the Society to any Person.
