**An Act to amend the Act of 1857 “to amend the  
“ Lower Canada Municipal and Road Act and to  
“ erect St. Lambert into a distinct municipality.”**

**WHEREAS** in the first section of the Act passed in the 20th year Preamble.  
of the reign of Her Majesty Queen Victoria, chaptered 132, and 20 V. c. 132.  
intituled “ An Act to amend the Lower Canada Municipal and Road  
“ Act of 1855 and to erect St Lambert into a distinct municipality,”  
5 the boundaries of the said municipality have been erroneously designated :  
And whereas such error would have the effect of rendering void the pro-  
ceedings of the said municipality : Therefore Her Majesty, &c., enacts  
as follows :

I. The first section of the said Act shall hereafter be interpreted as Error correctr  
ed.  
10 though the word “ parochial ” had been inserted in that section of the  
said Act in the place and stead of the word “ seigniorial,” wherever the  
said last word occurs.

II. All the proceedings had on account of and by the said municipal- Former

15 a valid as though the word “ parochial ” had been inserted at the time  
of the passing of the said Act, in the place and stead of the word  
“ seigniorial ” wherever it occurs in the said first section thereof.

III. This Act shall be deemed to be a public Act.
