An Act to regulate the holding of General Sessions of the Peace in the Districts of Kamouraska and Ottawa.

WHEREAS it is expedient to make more ample Legislative Preamble. provision for the holding of the Courts of General Sessions of the Peace in the Districts of Kamouraska and Ottawa; Be it therefore enacted, &c.,

5 That all the provisions of the Act passed in the Session held in the thirteenth and fourteenth years of Her Majesty's Reign, and intituled, "*An Act to facilitate the holding of Courts of General*
10 *or Quarter Sessions of the Peace in Lower Canada,*" except those of the second, third, ninth and tenth Sections thereof, shall
15 be and are hereby extended and shall apply to the Districts of Kamouraska and Ottawa in like manner as to the other Districts of Lower Canada; and the terms of the General Sessions of the Peace in and for the District of Kamouraska, shall commence at Kamouraska on the seventh day of January and the fiftéenth day of July in
20 each year, and the terms of the General Sessions of the Peae in and for the District of Ottawa, shall commence at Aylmer, on the fifth day of April and October in each year: Provided nevertheless Proviso. that if any of the said days be a Sunday or holyday, the said Sessions shall commence on the next juridical day thereafter.

Certain provisions of 13 and 14 Vic., cap. extended to the Districts of Kamouraska and Ottawa.
