The Secretary of State for External Affairs, the Honourable Paul Martin, announced today that Mr. Dirk Stikker, the retiring Secretary-General of the North Atlantic Treaty Organization, will pay a farewell visit to Canada on July 2. During his visit Mr. Stikker will call on the Prime Minister and members of the Government and will be guest of honour at a luncheon to be attended by members of the Government, leaders of all political parties, and senior officials. He will also be a guest of the Government at the Military Tattoo to be held in the presence of the Governor General on Parliament Hill on July 1.
