

This Association shall be known or styled as "The Millers' Name of Association of Canada West."

II.

The members of the Association shall consist of Mill Owners,
Mill Holders and Operative Millers, who may become members
on registering their names with the Secretary and paying an Who shall
entrance fee of Five Pounds, and shall bind themselves to pay an
annual fee or subscription of Two Pounds Ten Shillings.

III.

The proceedings of the Association shall be presided over by a President and Vice-President, (or, in their absence, by a Chairman to be chosen for the time being,) who shall be elected by ballot, on the first Wednesday of April in every year, (and shall continue in office until their successors are elected the following when year,) by those members of the Association who shall have paid elected. their entrance fee and annual subscription for the ensuing year; and any five members as above, being present, shall constitute a Board, and be a quorum for the transaction of business.

IV.

On the first Wednesday of April, in every year, a Secretary shall be elected for the ensuing year, who need not be a member be elected. of the Association, and who shall give security to the Association for any of its funds that may be entrusted to his eare.

v.

The duties of the Secretary shall be to act as Selling Broker to Duties of

Secretary.

the members of the Association, or such members thereof as may employ him, at a commission of one half of one per cent.

VI.

That the employment of the Secretary as such Selling Broker, shall be considered and taken as his remuneration for the performance of the other duties as Secretary.

VII.

To keep a regular Journal of the proceedings of the Board, and to earry out the wishes of the Association as expressed through the Board, and under the direction of the President and Vice-President to invest the funds of the Association; to arrange and obtain the latest, most correct and reliable information from abroad, affecting the interests of the Association; and, on receipt of such intelligence, it shall be immediately entered in a Book kept for the purpose; and shall forthwith mail a notice to each member, containing such intelligence, which shall be for the sole use of the said members, without preference to any. And shall also record in a Book to be kept for that purpose, all sales of produce reported by members or known to the Secretary.

Duties of Secretary.

VIII.

In the absence of the Sceretary, the President or Officer presiding, shall appoint one of the members present to act in his place for the time being.

IX.

Duties of Secretary. That the Secretary notify all members of the Association of the time and place of every Annual or Special Meeting.

X.

That subscriptions shall in all cases be paid in advance, and none other than paying members shall frequent the rooms of the Privileges of Association, nor take any part in any of the proceedings thereof, or derive any advantage therefrom; and it shall be the duty of the Officers to enforce this rule.

XI.

The Rooms of the Association shall be kept open by the Secretary, to members entitled to access, daily, (Sundays except-Business. ed.) from 10 o'clock, A.M., till 4 o'clock, P.M.

XIII.

Any amendment, alteration or addition to the constitution, shall require a vote of two-thirds of the members present, and votes for such vote shall not take effect unless due notice shall have been amending or altering the given, and until it shall have been assented to at two regular constitution. meetings.

XIV.

That a room or rooms be provided for the use of the Association, in some central place, in which the meetings shall be held, Rooms for and in which shall be kept all books and papers belonging to the Association.

XV.

That the Members of the Association shall meet on Wednesday, in every week, at 3 o'clock, P. M.

XV1.

That there shall be a Standing Committee of Five Members, to be called "The Flour, and Grain Arbitration Committee," to whom may be referred all disputes in relation to the purchase and sale of Flour, Wheat, and produce generally. This Com-Flour and mittee shall consist of the President, Vice-President, who shall Grain Arbitration be ex-officio members, and three members of the Association, Committee. to be elected by ballot on the first Wednesday in April, in every year, one of whom shall be Chairman of such Committee.

XVII.

Interested parties not permitted to act on Arbitration Committees.

That no member of the Arbitration Committee shall act thereon when any question in which he is a party interested, shall be before them, but his place shall be supplied by the Board, electing a member of the Association in his stead for the time being.

XVIII.

That any member of the Association who shall, by the Arbitration Committee, be declared wilfully guilty of violating any contract which shall have been submitted to their consideration, Violation of or to do or commit any act contrary to the Constitution, By-laws or Resolutions of this Association, shall forfeit the right and privilege of Membership, on such Report being confirmed by the Board.

XIX.

Journals, Ac., to be provided.

XX.

How Special Meetings may be called.

That on a Requisition signed by any five Members of the Association, the President, or in his absence, the Vice-President, may call a Special Meeting.

XXI.

That an Act of Incorporation may be applied for at as early a Act of Incortion. date as may be convenient, if the Board deem it expedient.
