

Some Things We Believe

That the Bible was written by men inspired of God. That God is its Author; and its revelations are to teach men how to live; That it reveals the principal by which God will judge us in the last day; That it is the last court of appeal in all matters concerning spiritual things.

Π

We believe there is one and only one true and living God; Whose name is Jehovah, the maker and ruler of heaven and earth?; inexpressible in holiness and worthy of all possible honor, confidence and love. That there are three persons in the God head; The Father Son' and Holy Spirit; that they are equal in devine perfection and power, and execute distinct but harmonious offices in the work of redemption.

III

We believe that man has fallen from his holy estate with Gol, and that all inherit his depraved nature, and as a consequence are lost; and will be lost without the vicarious sacrifice of the Lord Jesus, which he must accept by faith, in order to be restored.

IV

That all who believe in the Lord Jesus Christ "are justified from all things from which they could not be justified by deeds of law." By virtue of this faith, we are accepted, and are received as adopted children of God.

. That regeneration is a work wrought in the heart by the Holy Spirit, through which the life is changed, and we become obedient to divine truth; and that its evidence or fruit is in a life cheerfully surrendered to the service of the Lord Jesus Christ.

VI

We believe that the doctrine of election is taught in the word of God, and is perfectly consistant with the free agency of man; that it encourages the use of means in the highest degree, and is the foundation of our Christian assurance.

VII

That sanctification is development of spiritual life—a setting apart of our life more fully to God's service.

That it begins at regeneration and ends at death, and is carried forward by means employed—prayer, study of God's word, public worship, and all service rendered to Our Lord, private or public.

VIII

We believe all true believers will continue to the end; that persevering attachment to Christ, is the line drawn between them and superficial believers, that they will be kept by power divine unto the end.

IX

We believe a visible church of Christ is a company of baptised believers banded together in the fellowship of the gospel; having the ordinances duly administered and existing for the salvation of lost man, and the glory of God. That the only officers are Bishops or pastors, and Deacons; as revealed in Paul's Epistle to Timothy and Titus.

X

That our Lord gave the Church two ordinances—Baptism and the Lord's Supper. That Baptism is immersion of a believer in water, in the name of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit that this ordinance is symbolic; ever representing the resurrection from the dead; and our resurrection from spiritual death and distruction. The Lord's Supper is the eating and drinking of Bread and Wine as a type of the death of our Lord Jesus. We thus eating in figure, the body and blood of Christ. The ordinances belong to the Church, and should never be observed independent of the church.

XI.

We believe that the first day of the week is the Lord's Day, and

is to be kept sacred to religious pur poses; that we are to abstain from any secular labor, except works of necessity, and deeds of mercy.

We are to observe all means of grace possible, that God may be honored in me.

IIX

We believe the end of the world is approaching, and that at the last day, Christ will descend from Heaven and will raise the bodies of the dead, and reunite them by His power with their spirits, and will sit upon His throne of judgment and will divide the wicked and Righteous, sending one into eternal death and the other into eternal life. That there will be no further chance given men to repent and accept the salvation of God.

Church Covenant.

Having been led, as we believe by the Spirit of God to receive the Lord Jesus Christ as our Saviour, and on the profession of our faith, having been baptised in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, we do now in the presence of God, angels and this assembly, most solemnly and joyfully enter into covenant with one another as one body in Christ.

We engage therefore by the aid of the Holy Spirit to walk together in christian love; to strive for the advancement of this church, in knowledge, holiness, and comfort; to promote its prosperity and spirituality; to sustain the worship, ordinances, discipline, and doctrines; to contribute cheerfully and regularly to the support of the ministry, the expenses of the church, the relief of the poor, and the spread of the gospel throughout all nations.

We also engage to maintain family and secret devotion; to religiously educate our children; to seek the salvation of our kindred and acquaintances; to walk circum spectly in the world; to be just in our dealing, faithful in our engagements, and exemplary in our deportment; to avoid all tattling, back-biting and excessive anger; to abstain from the sale or use of intoxicating drinks as a beverage, and to be zealous in our efforts to advance the kingdom of our Saviour.

We further engage to watch over one another in brotherly love; to remember each other in prayer; to aid each other in sickness and distress; to cultivate Christian sympathy in feeling, and courtesy in speech; to be slow to take offence, but always ready for reconciliation and remindful of the rules of our Saviour to seek it without delay.

We moreover engage, that when we remove from this place, we will as soon as possible unite with some other church, where we

can carry out the spirit of this covenant and the principles of God's word. Amen.

Our Sunday School numbers 485 scholars
