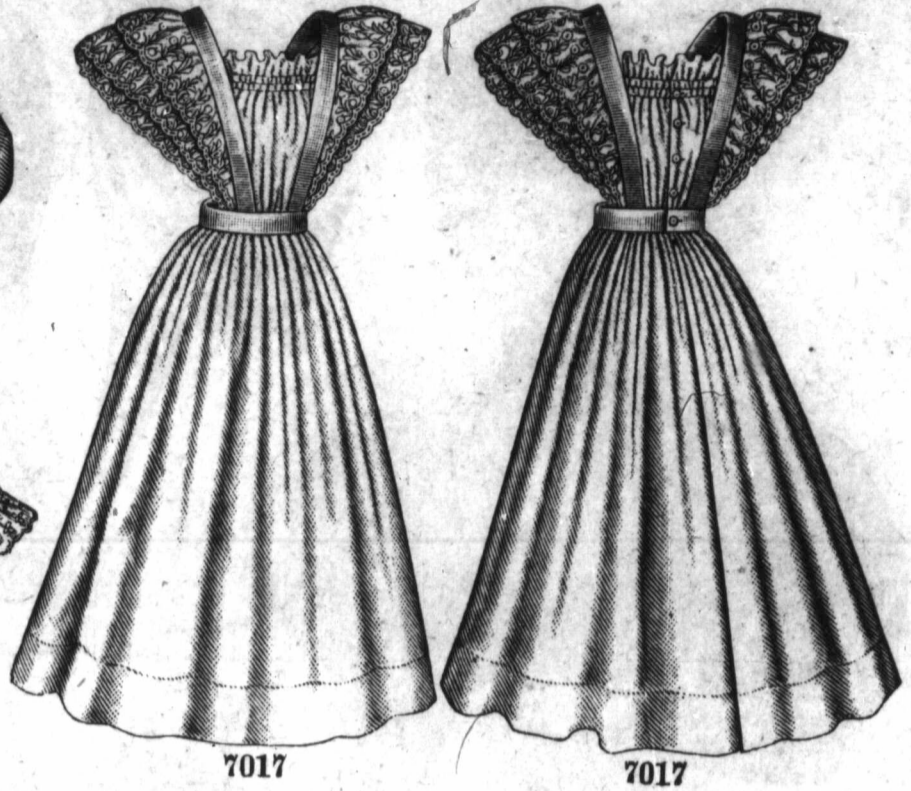




LADIES' DRESSING-SACK. (TO BE MADE WITH A ROLLING OR A SAILOR COLLAR.) (COPYRIGHT.)  
 No. 7022.—The pattern of the comfortably fashioned garment here portrayed is in 13 sizes for ladies from 28 to 46 inches, bust measure. To make the sack of one material for a lady of medium size, will require 5 7/8 yards of goods 22 inches wide, or 4 1/4 yards 30 inches wide, or 3 1/2 yards 44 inches wide. Price of pattern, 25 cts.



MISSES' APRON. (COPYRIGHT.)  
 No. 7017.—A pretty garment is here represented developed in white lawn and embroidered edging. The pattern is in 9 sizes for misses from 8 to 16 years old. To make the apron for a miss of 12 years, requires 2 1/4 yards of nainsook 36 inches wide, with 4 1/4 yards of embroidered edging 5 1/4 inches wide. Of one material, it needs 4 1/4 yards 22 inches wide, or 2 7/8 yards 36 inches wide. Price of pattern, 20 cts.



LADIES' TIGHT-FITTING COAT, WITH ETON FRONT. (COPYRIGHT.)  
 No. 7016.—This pattern is in 13 sizes for ladies from 28 to 46 inches, bust measure. To make the garment for a lady of medium size, will require 2 3/4 yards of cloth 54 inches wide, with 2 3/8 yards of moiré 20 inches wide. Of one material, it calls for 8 1/2 yards 22 inches wide, or 4 1/8 yards 44 inches wide, or 3 1/2 yards 54 inches wide. Price of pattern, 30 cts.



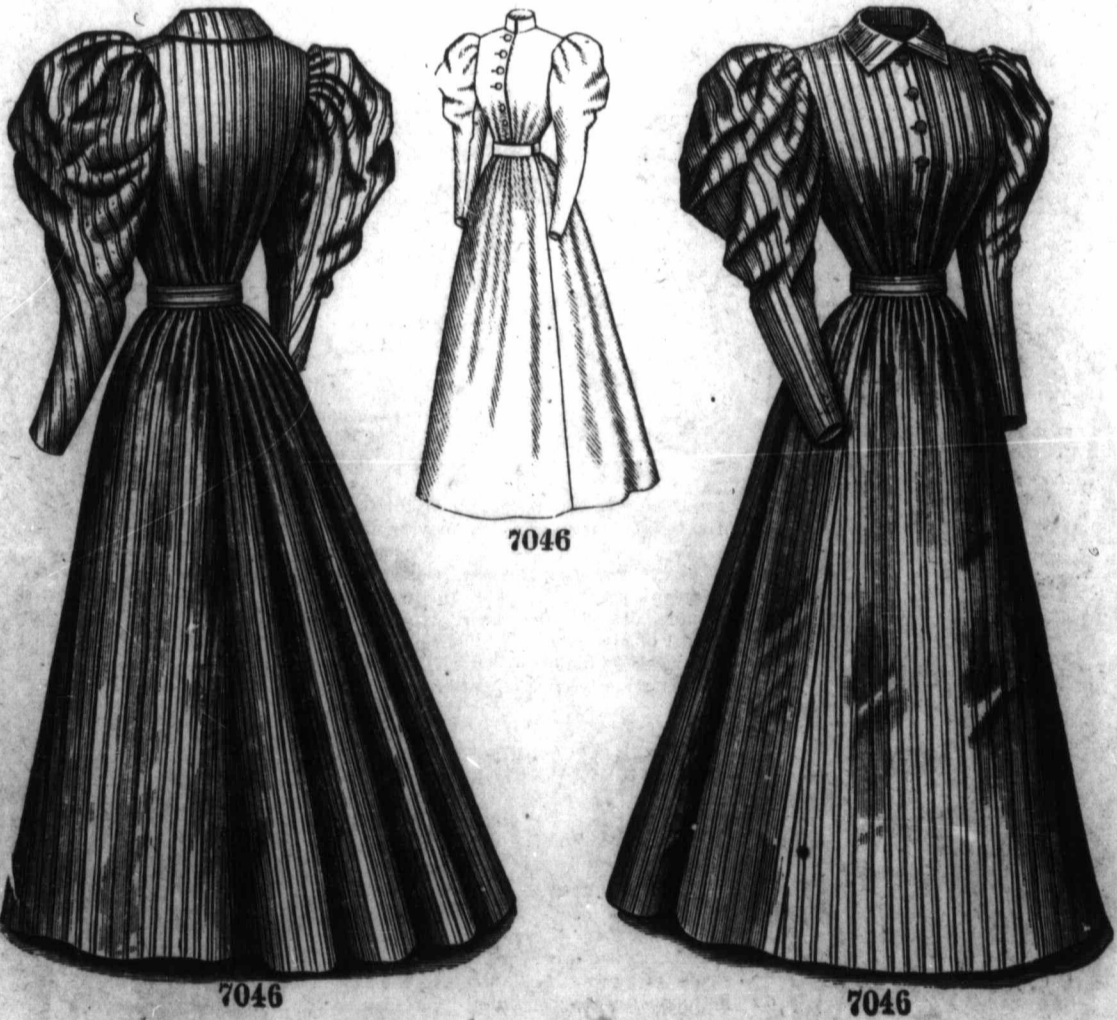
LADIES' DRESS SLEEVE, WITH PUFF EXTENDING TO THE ELBOW. (COPYRIGHT.)  
 No. 7035.—This pattern is in 7 sizes for ladies from 9 to 15 inches, arm measure, measuring the arm about an inch below the bottom of the arm's-eye. A pair of sleeves for a lady whose arm measures 11 inches as described, will require 2 7/8 yards of material 22 inches wide, or 2 yards 30 inches wide, or 1 1/2 yard 44 inches wide, or 1 1/4 yard 50 inches wide. LITTLE GIRLS' DRESS. (COPYRIGHT.)  
 No. 7028.—This pattern is in 8 sizes for little girls from 2 to 9 years of age. For a girl of 5 years, the dress calls for 3 yards of blue chambray 27 inches wide, with 1 1/4 yard of white lawn 36 inches wide, and 3/4 yard of embroidered edging 2 1/4 inches wide. Of one material, it will need 5 3/8 yards 22 inches wide, or 4 1/4 yards 30 inches wide, or 2 3/4 yards 44 inches wide. Price of pattern, 20 cts.



GIRLS' DRESS. (TO BE MADE WITH A ROLLING OR A STANDING COLLAR.) (COPYRIGHT.)  
 No. 7015.—This pattern is most desirable for young people and is in 11 sizes for girls from 2 to 12 years of age. To make the dress of one material for a girl of 8 years, requires 5 yards 22 inches wide, or 4 yards 30 inches wide, or 2 5/8 yards 44 inches wide. Price of pattern, 20 cts.



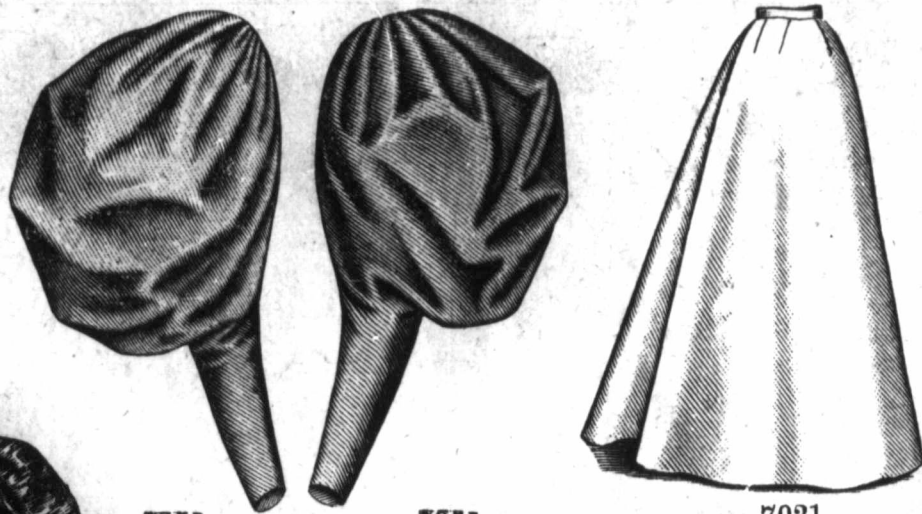

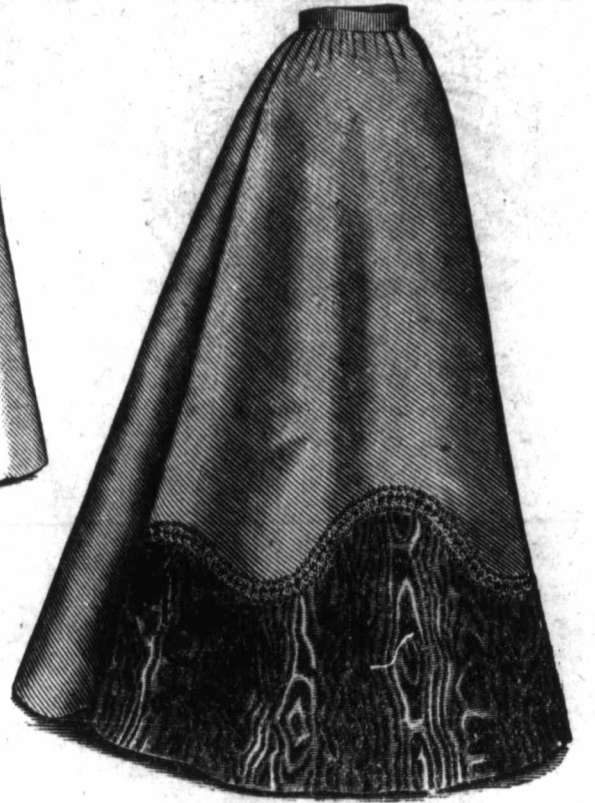


FIGURE No. 268 K.—LADIES' PLAIN ROUND BASQUE.

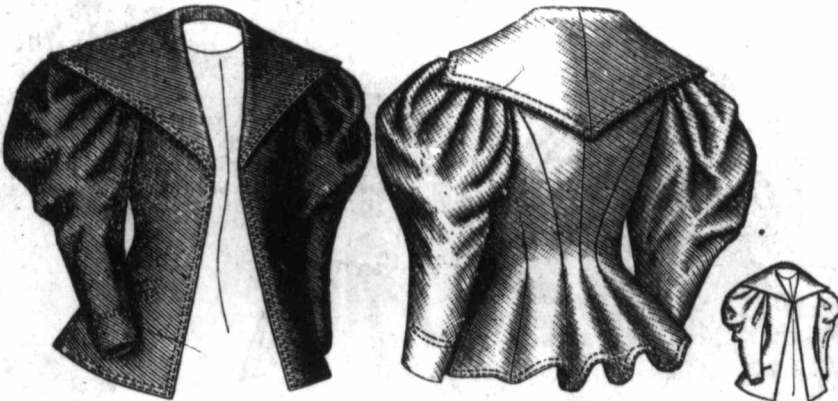

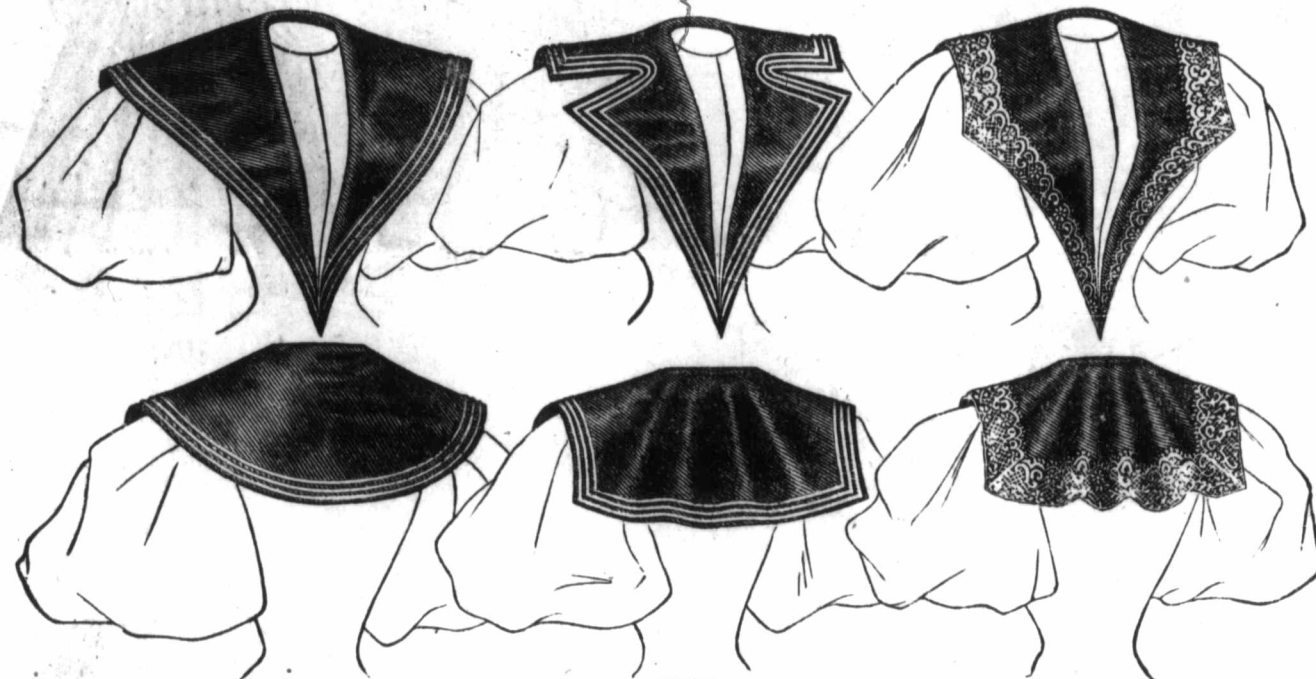

No. 7021.—This skirt consists of a circular front and a fancy facing that may be omitted, and two fluted or *godet* back-gores. 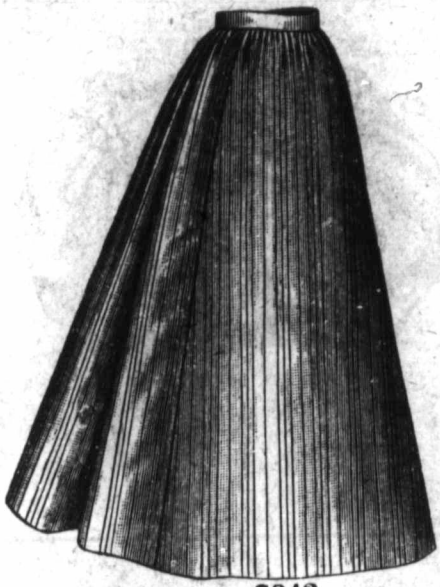

 No. 7039.—One of these yokes is again shown at figure No. 259 K on this page. The pattern is in 3 sizes, small, medium and large. In the medium size, either style of yoke closing in front needs  $\frac{3}{8}$  yard of goods 20 inches wide, or  $\frac{3}{4}$  yard 27 inches wide, or  $\frac{1}{2}$  yard 36 inches wide; while either style closing on the shoulder requires  $\frac{3}{8}$  yard 20 inches wide, or  $\frac{3}{4}$  yard 27 inches wide, or  $\frac{5}{8}$  yard 36 inches wide. 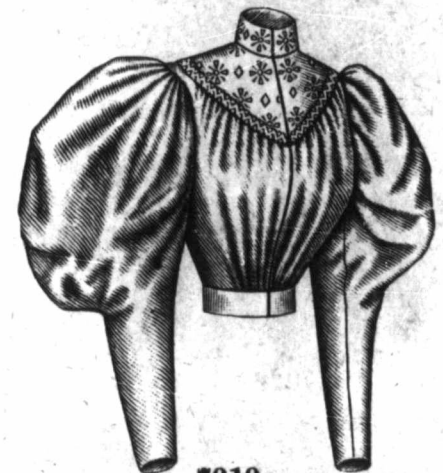

No. 7019.—The pattern of this prettily fashioned waist is in 13 sizes for ladies from 28 to 46 inches, bust measure. For a lady of medium size, it needs  $3\frac{3}{8}$  yards of wash goods 36 inches wide, together with  $\frac{5}{8}$  yard of all-over embroidery 27 inches wide. Of one material it requires  $4\frac{3}{4}$  yards 22 inches wide, or  $3\frac{5}{8}$  yards 30 inches wide, or  $2\frac{3}{4}$  yards 44 inches wide. Price of pattern, 25 cents.

GIRLS' SAILOR BLOUSE. (COPYRIGHT.)

No. 7006.—This pattern is in 7 sizes for girls from 3 to 9 years of age. To make the blouse for a girl of 8 years, requires  $2\frac{1}{4}$  yards of blue and  $\frac{1}{2}$  yard of white serge 40 inches wide. Of one material, it needs  $3\frac{3}{4}$  yards 22 inches wide, or  $3\frac{1}{4}$  yards 30 inches wide, or  $2\frac{3}{4}$  yards 44 inches wide. Price of pattern, 20 cents.

FIGURE No. 259 K.—This shows one of the styles of yoke in pattern No. 7039 (copyright), which is shown again on this page; the pointed sleeve-cap in pattern No. 6996 (copyright), differently portrayed on its label; and sleeve No. 7055 (copyright), seen on page 4. The yoke and cap patterns are both in 3 sizes, small, medium and large; the sleeve pattern is in 7 sizes for ladies from 9 to 15 inches, arm measure; and each costs 10 cents. In the medium size, a pair of caps needs  $\frac{3}{4}$  yard of goods 20 inches wide, and the yoke  $\frac{3}{8}$  yard in the same width. For a lady whose arm measures 11 inches, a pair of sleeves calls for  $3\frac{1}{8}$  yards of material 22 inches wide.



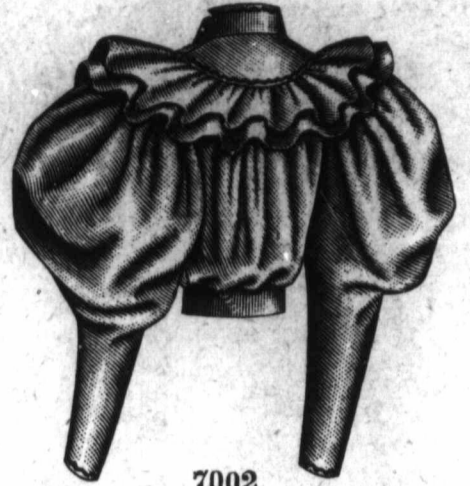
FIGURE No. 269 K.—LADIES' MATINÉE.

The pattern is in 10 sizes for ladies from 28 to 46 inches, bust measure, and costs 25 cents. To make the matinée for a lady of medium size, requires 7½ yards of goods 22 inches wide, or 5½ yards 30 inches wide. Of material 44 inches wide, 4¾ yards will be sufficient.

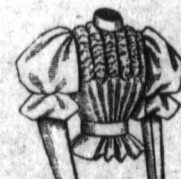

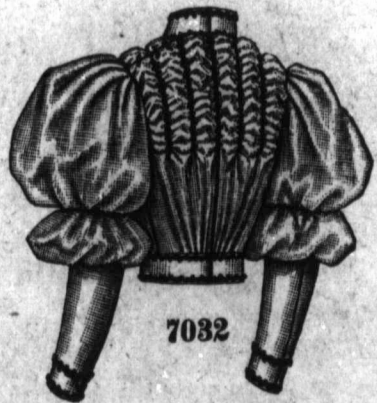
