Colts exhibited with their dams in sections 3, 8, 19, are eligible to compete in sections 15, 24; but no other animal in this class will be allowed to compete in more than one section.

In all cases of doubt as to soundness, the Judges will call in the service of the Consulting Veterinarian.

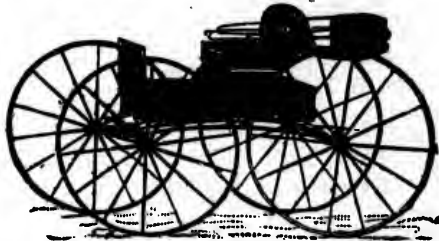

Roots must be cleaned and topped, and surplus roots and fibres removed, before being taken to the grounds or building. Potatoes must be exhibited in half-bushel boxes, which will be furnished by the Committee.

Judges must take into consideration the perfection of the growth of Roots, and not size alone, also the manner in which they are presented for exhibition.
