TRANSMISSION OF POWER.

Translated From "The Ingenieur-Consell" of July 15, 1899

Transmission by belts is a relic of routine which should be rooted out, as has been already done with the ancient gear-wheel transmission.

Why? We cannot explain, but when the next Exposition opens we will see if they continue to inflict upon their patrons a mode of transmission which, whatever be the ingenuity of the makers of belts, leather, cotton or steel, will always absorb more power and cause more stoppages than transmission by ropes.

At the Exposition transmission by ropes is practised by three Belgian firms, two Swiss firms and two French all others employ belts.

While thirty years have so far failed to show the practical advantages of the English multiple in the year 1860 only seven users of it appear in the year 1889.
