



REPORT.

The General Missionary Committee,

To the Friends and Supporters of the Canadian P. M. Missions.

In coming before you once more, it affords us pleasure to be able to inform you, that on the whole of our work we have realized an increase in our membership of 61 ; still, we cannot hide from ourselves the fact, that this increase is not as large as we had a right to expect, when we consider the number of agents employed, and extent of territory occupied. Had there been more faithfulness in the performance of our duties ; had greater devotion to our mission, as Christians, been observed ; had closer communion with God been cultivated ; had the power of the Holy Spirit been more earnestly sought for ; and earnest, agonizing prayer more extensively offered, we should have numbered our increase not merely by scores, but by hundreds ; for, let it not be forgotten, our religion is the same as that which Christ taught and the apostles preached. It has undergone no change, not can it, for like its divine Author, it is unalterable. The memory of its past achievements cling to us ; and if we possess the right conditions of mind, the same achievements can be repeated in our day. It is therefore no fault of it, that sinners are not more extensively converted, and Christians not more useful. Prompted by its impulses ; filled with its spirit, and influenced by its power, we must be successful : neither the indifference of the worldling, nor the apathy of the lukewarm professor, can prevent us. An earnest, believing, godly man cannot be successfully resisted. He quickens all with whom he comes in contact, and is instrumental in saving men's souls. The history of the universal Church proves this ; nor are proofs of this fact wanting amongst us as a denomination. Stations under the charge of agents of feeble spiritual vitality and easy going habits have declined in piety, decreased in numbers, and sank in finances ; but under the supervision of men whose hearts were in the work, have undergone a complete change. These men have flung themselves with all their soul into the mighty conflict, between

truth and error. They were not discouraged by seeing lions in the way ; they conjured up no difficulties ; they feared no foes. They sought help from God. They besieged the throne, until they were clothed *with power* ; and thus they went forth to do battle for Christ, and were successful. Under their labours, the barren soil became fruitful ; saints were quickened ; sinners were saved ; and all the interests of the Church revived ; and so it will be to the end. Earnestness, perseverance, faith and prayer, will be more than a match for all the forces of sin. May labourers possessing these qualifications multiply ! They are needed in our day, more perhaps than in former days. The world needs them ; the Church needs them ; our country needs them ; and as a denomination we need them. We have a great work to do, and we must do it. In the face of a rapidly increasing population, we cannot relax our efforts ; nay, we must rather redouble them. To us, as a people, a dispensation of the Gospel has been committed, and woe to us if we are unfaithful. We therefore need agents whose hearts are all aglow with holy ardour. We continue to receive calls for help from different parts of our work ; and though the number of our agents has been increased, we need more, to respond to those calls. At the time of preparing this Report, we have from new fields pressing requests for additional labourers. Will you assist us in procuring them ? We gratefully acknowledge your help in this direction on former occasions, and now confidently solicit a repetition of that help. God has dealt kindly with you all ; and bountifully with many of you. Minister of your carnal things, to His spiritual things. " Honour the Lord with thy substance, and with the first fruits of thy increase." " Withhold not good from them to whom it is due, when it is in the power of thine hand to do it," and then the Lord will bless the work of thy hands.

The Parent Society is still pursuing its onward course. From the last Report of its operations, we gather that it has on Home Mission Stations 123 Missionaries, and 8,876 Members. In Australia, besides self-supporting Stations, 30 Missionaries, and 1,911 Members. In New Zealand, 4 Missionaries, and 396 Members. These figures have all been considerably increased since the publication of the Report, in last December. The African Mission is doing well, and the Missionaries have been increased. There are now four employed, and new fields are opening, which will

require increased agents. Altogether, the Society has under its care, including our Canadian Missions, 211 Missionaries, and 13,898 Members. Its Missionary receipts, from all sources, amounted to \$115,568 00, being an increase on the previous year's income of \$13,590. This proves that the Denomination has not lost the Missionary spirit and zeal which distinguished it in its earliest years.

The returns made to our last Conference show that we have 43 Missionaries, and 2,841 Members. These figures show an increase of 3 Missionaries and 70 Members. Our financial position is as follows :—Contributions from our own work \$7,269 35. We regret that in this department there should be a decrease. Balance from last year \$3,392 86; English Grant \$2,443 33; making a total of \$13,095 54. Our expenditure has been \$9,832 01; leaving a balance of \$3,263 53. But, lest this statement of balance should make a wrong impression on your minds, it is necessary for us to state, that since the Conference, the August grants and Missionaries' removal expenses, with other claims, have been made, so that at the time of writing this Report there is not one cent in the Treasurer's hands; and we require an increase of \$800 00 over last year's income, to place the Society in a safe position. Yet we have no fears respecting the future. We know we are working for God, and He can put it into the hearts of His people to provide the means necessary to carry on His own work. With this belief, we now commit the whole matter to your sympathy, prayers, and help, and may God approve the act!

Note.—As (with the exceptions of two or three) the brethren on Mission Stations have failed to make their usual report, we are not able to give any this year.


