BILL.

An Act to repeal so much of the Imperial Act 31st Geo. III. chap. 31, as relates to Rectories, and the presentation of Incumbents to the same.

WHEREAS it is expedient to deprive the Crown or Preamble.
the Government of this Province of the power of constituting, creating and endowing Parsonages or Rectories within the same, and presenting incumbents or ministers to Parsonages or Rectories: Be it therefore enacted, &c.,

That the 38th, 39th, and 40th sections of the Act of the Parliament of Great Britain, passed in the thirty-first year of the Reign of King George the Third, intituled "*An Act to*
Sect. 38, 39, 40. of Imp. Act 31 Geo. 3. c. 31, repealed.
10 "*repeal certain parts of an Act passed in the fourteenth year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled 'An Act for making more effectual provision for the Government of the Province of Quebec, in North America, and to make further provision for the Government of the said Province,'*" passed in the
15 thirty-first year of the Reign of His late Majesty, King George the Third, be and the same are hereby repealed; Provided always, that nothing herein contained shall legalize or be construed to legalize any rectory or rectories now constituted or supposed to be constituted, or in
20 any presentation or presentations to the same. Proviso.
