**An Act to abolish the office of Inspector of Common Schools in Lower Canada.**

**WHEREAS** the office of Inspector of Common Schools in Lower Preamble.  
Canada has been found unnecessary and useless, inasmuch as the  
duties of that office are by law required to be performed by the Local  
5 Boards of Examiners, and by the School Commissioners, and it is  
expedient to abolish the said office : Therefore, Her Majesty, by and  
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of  
Canada, enacts as follows :

1. From and after the passing of this Act, the office of Inspector of Office abol-
