Report of the Council

FOR THE YEAR 1890.



THE Royal Canadian Academy of Arts since its organization in 1880, has accomplished much for Art and its advancement in the Dominion. Eleven Annual Exhibitions have been held successively, in Ottawa, Montreal and Toronto. It has held one in Halifax and one in St. John, N.B., and we have reason to congratulate our members that each recurring exhibition has shown great advance in the quality of work by members of the Academy, and others who have exhibited.

The Annual Meeting held in the Art Association Gallery, in Montreal, last year, was well attended, and much interest was taken in advancing the objects for which the Academy was formed. The exhibition was a thorough success, and a number of pictures were sold. We regret that our patron, Lord Stanley, Governor General, was unable to open the exhibition on the evening of the private view.

Mr. O. R. Jacobi was elected President of the Academy for 1890 and '91, and a cordial vote of thanks was given to our late President, Mr. L. R. O'Brien, for the many services rendered the Academy during his ten years of office as President.

We have much pleasure in stating that the Academy donated pictures to the National Gallery at Ottawa, "to the value of eight hundred dollars," which have been duly forwarded and hung on its walls.

The accounts for the past year are submitted, showing our receipts, expenditure, and balance on hand.

The usual grants in aid of Life Classes, in Montreal and Ottawa were made.

We have to report that Messrs. Paul Peel, of London, Ont., and G. A. Reid, of Toronto, were elected to the rank of Academician Painters, and that Messrs. A. F. Dunlop and A. T. Taylor, of Montreal were elected Academician Architects.

Messrs. C. M. Manly and F. M. Knowles, and Miss Tully, of Toronto, also P. G. Wickson, of Paris, Ont., and John Hammond, of St. John, N.B., were elected as Associate Painters of the Academy.

We have to mourn the loss of Mr. W. H. Perré, one of our oldest and most esteemed Academician Painters, and one of our valuable Associates, Mr. A. D. Steele, architect of Montreal, who died in England.

The Council have made arrangements to hold the Annual Exhibition of the Academy, in the Toronto Art Gallery, King street west, on the 5th of March, next.
