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ARRIVAL OF THE KINCARDINE SHIRE COLONISTS.

The many eager watchers for the arrival of the Castalia have at last been gratified by seeing the ship steam up the harbor, and moor at her wharf.

The Minister of Marine replied that the Government had asked Her Majesty's ministers to delay legislation respecting Canadian ships, or to exempt Canadian ships from the operation of the law.

The House went into committee on the bill, and Mr. Mitchell's bill relating to the registration of shipping.

After the discussion of legal points by Mr. Palmer and others the bill passed.

A bill containing the Insolvency law was read, also a bill amending the act respecting militia and defence.

The House adjourned at one o'clock.
