BILL.

An Act to authorize the payment of certain Expenses of the administration of Justice in the Recorders' Courts in Upper Canada, out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of this Province.

WHEREAS it is expedient that the expenses of the administration of Justice in Criminal Cases in the Recorders' Courts in Upper Canada, should be defrayed by the Province to the same extent to which such expenses were so defrayed when incurred in the Courts for which such Recorders' Courts are substituted: Be it therefore enacted, &c.,

Preamble.

That the Expenses of the Administration of Justice in Criminal Cases in the Recorders' Courts established or to be established in the several Cities of Upper Canada, under the provisions of the Act passed in the twelfth year of Her Majesty's Reign, and intituled, "*An Act to provide, by one general law, for the erection of Municipal Corporations, and the establishment of Regulations of Police, in and for the several Counties, Cities, Towns, Townships and Villages, in Upper Canada,*" or of any Act amending the same, to be incurred after the first day of January next, shall be defrayed out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of this Province, in like manner and to the like extent as the expenses attending the administration of Justice in Criminal Cases in the several Courts of Quarter Sessions in Upper Canada.

Certain expenses of administration of Justice in Recorders' Courts to be paid out of Provincial Funds.
