

The suit against Warren Soper, President of the Ottawa Electric Railway Company; Thomas Fane and Charles Lavender, as proprietors of the Comet Building on Temple-street, for an alleged breach of the provisions of a sub-lease to James G. Littlejohn, is being heard by Mr. Justice Meredith in the Non-Jury Court.

When the Comet Cycle Company terminated their lease of the building the proprietors also cut short Littlejohn's sub-lease and neglected to supply him with steam power, for all of which he claims damages.

SPENCE'S SCHEME KILLED.

Ministerial Association Does Not Believe in 100,000 Pledges for Prohibition-It is All at elections.

The scheme for coercing voters to pledge themselves to abstain from drinking liquor at elections, which was presented at the meeting of the Ministerial Association in the Y.M.C.A. library yesterday morning, by a deputation from the Dominion Alliance, was given poor support.

The deputation was headed by Ald. F. S. Spence, and consisted of L. G. Giesey, H. Orr, Mrs. Stevens and Mrs. Vance.

Mr. Spence, spokesman of the party, read the circular as issued by the Dominion Alliance, calling upon 100,000 voters to pledge themselves for prohibition and not to be influenced by other political considerations.

The circular also contained a paragraph in reference to the action of the Government in refusing to recognize the wish of the people and put prohibition in effect.

Proposed Political Pledge. In part the circular stated: "The traffic in liquor is still legalised and upheld, although its advocates were beaten at the polls, and the right-of-way is given to the liquor traffic, to tyrannical and iniquitous minority rule."

Mr. Spence suggested that the committee of the Government and Parliament, this day, should put prohibition in effect, because we cannot consent to the continuance of the liquor traffic, with its fearful and horrible consequences, nor to the course of our legislators in introducing legislation in spite of the prayers and votes of the people.

Here is the Pledge. We, the undersigned, promise that, at the next general election for the Dominion Parliament, we will vote for such candidates as will agree to do all in their power to effect the immediate enactment of such legislation as will secure the total prohibition of the liquor traffic in all provinces and territories.

Would Not Go on Committee. Mr. Spence suggested that the committee of three members be appointed to secure signatures for the pledge, but none of the members would consent to become a committee, and the proposal fell through.

While we deeply sympathize with the object of the pledge, we do not think we deem it best that each minister should write out a pledge that is best classed as a judgment.

It was arranged to have an exchange of pledges Sunday, 22nd inst. The paper promulgated by Rev. Dyson Hague was not read.

London, April 2.-The Nationalist members of Parliament held a meeting in the House of Commons this afternoon under the chairmanship of Mr. John Redmond, the leader of the Irish Nationalist party, in commemoration of the centenary of the union of Great Britain and Ireland.

A resolution was adopted, and the right-of-way is given to the liquor traffic, to tyrannical and iniquitous minority rule.
