

## BILT.

An Act to repeal the Acts and provisions of Law relative to Assessments and matters connected therewith in Upper Canada.

HEREAS it is expedient to repeal the several Acts Presumble. and provisions of Law relating to assessments and local taxation, and to Statute Labour, in Upper Canada, 4 to the end that more equal and just provisions may be made with regard to the matters aforesaid: Be it therefore 6 enacted. &c.
