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

## BILL.

An Act to enable the Rector of the Protestant Parish of Perth, with the consent of the Bishop of his Diocese, to raise a loan on certain Church property for the purpose of finishing the Parish Church.

Received and read, first time, Tuesday, 22nd March, 1869.

TORONTO:

An Act to enable the Rector of the Protestant Episcopal Church at Perth, in the County of Lanark, with the consent of the Bishop and Church Wardens, to raise a loan on certain Church property for the purpose of finishing the Parish Church.

HEREAS the Reverend Richard L. Stephenson, Master of Arts, Preamble. and Rector of the Parsonage or Rectory and Parish Church of Perth, Andrew W. Playfair and George Graham, the Church Wardens thereof, have, by their Petition to the Legislature represented, that the 5 former Parochial Church of the said Parish having been inadequate for the requirements of the Parish, and being in a dilapidated condition, was taken down for the purpose of building another on the same site: And whereas a Parochial or Parish Church hath in a great part been built thereon, but cannot, for want of sufficient funds, be completed, 10 and the petitioners have prayed for authority to raise a loan for the purpose of completing the said Church, on the security of the said lots of ground and of the Church and buildings thereon, and on the security of the lands hereafter mentioned, which prayer it is expedient to grant: Therefore, Her Majesty, &c., enacts as follows:

Stephenson, Rector, and the Church Wardens of the said Parish Church of Perth, and their successors in their office aforesaid; that 30 is to say; The whole of such part or parts of the North half of Lot Number Six, on the north side of Craig street, and of Lots Numbers Five and Six on the south side of Harvey street, in the Town of Perth, aforesaid, and also the East half of the Clergy Reserve Lot Numbers Twenty-

I. It shall be lawful for the said Reverend Richard L. Stephenson, or The Rector,
