The Canadian Government chartered steamer Beothic, which went ashore at Point Rich while bound from Halifax to Hudson Bay, returned this morning to this port under her own steam from North Sydney, where Capt. Saunders, Lloyd's agent, had inspected the ship.

The repairs, he expected, will all be completed in two or three days and the Beothic will again be ready to sail.

The Captain of H. M. S. Sirius held a survey on the ship before leaving Bonaville Bay. He reported that the ship was in good condition for being towed to H. M. S. Sirius, but the towing did not occur until some 300 tons of coal had been thrown overboard.
