An Act to amend the Law relating to the sale of Lands  
for taxes in Upper Canada.

**W**HEREAS it is desirable that the titles of purchasers of lands sold **Preamble.**  
for taxes should after an allotted time be freed from objections of a  
merely technical character arising from reports in the proceedings prior to  
such sales; Therefore Her Majesty, &c., enacts as follows:

- 5 I. No sale of lands in Upper Canada made after the passing of this **Title of pur-**  
Act, for any arrears of taxes, imposed under the authority of any Act of **chaser at sale**  
the Legislature of this Province, shall be liable to be questioned in any suit or **for Taxes,**  
proceeding either at Law or in Equity, after the expiration of three years from **questionable**  
the time of such sale, for any defect or irregularity in any of the proceed- **for certain**  
10 ings prior to such sale, except that there were no arrears whatever of taxes **causes only**  
due upon such lands, or that there was sufficient property to distrain upon **after a certain**  
such lands for any arrears due, at the time of such sale. **time.**
