NICKEL FOR ARMOR PLATES.

THE CANADIAN SOURCE OF SUPPLY FOR THE AMERICAN NAVY.

Trade With the United States Has Attracted British Experts to this Industry.

(Correspondence of New York Tribune, Dec. 23.) SUDBURY, Ont., Dec. 18.—This is the place where the United States Navy Department obtains its nickel for the manufacture of nickel-steel armor plates.

Copper was discovered here during the construction of the Canadian Pacific railway. The nickel ore—nickeliferous pyrrhotite—is the technical name—is found in the midst of rocks of different characters belonging to different horizons.
