YREKA, Cal., May 14.—A shepherd tending his flocks in Kildere Hills entered a cave and, stumbling, stooped to pick up an obstruction. DETROIT, May 14.—A Catholic mob attacked an Orangeman's funeral procession yesterday afternoon in Fort-Down. The funeral was for James J. Ryan, who was killed in a riot on Monday last. Revolvers and clubs were used on both sides and before the police arrived one man was killed and several others were injured. The police separated the combatants, arrested 14 men who were in the line of the funeral and were retreating with their rifles when the mob turned on them and tried to force the funeral to proceed.

OTTAWA, May 14.—Hon. Mr. Foster tonight gives notice of following further tariff changes: Upper leather, including dogskin, cordovan, kid, lamb, sheep and calf, dressed, waxed or glazed, 17 1/2 per cent. ad valorem. Feces, manure, grab hose, axle hutchins and poles for cars, and edge tools of all descriptions, 35 per cent. ad valorem. Shovels and spades, ad valorem. Blanks, metal, or steel cut to shape for same, 50 cents per dozen and 25 per cent. ad valorem.

His brain was dashed out, his neck, both arms and both legs were broken and one side of the face being crushed in.

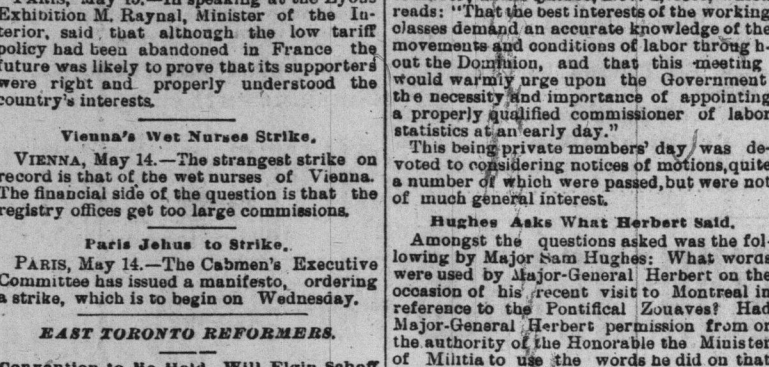
