The Household.

When the Baby Cries.

The first cry of the baby, when he enters this vale of woe is perhaps the only time the mother feels to hear it, but in reality the wailings of the young child so long as he seems ordinarily healthy, need not worry her so much.

Do not be alarmed at these first manifestations as long as his organs are in good working order. Even at a later period of his life a good, healthy baby will be sure to discover the meaning of the cry if you can't tell him, but you can't tell him until he has learned to cry vociferously.

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
