An Act to provide for the more speedy Distribution of the Statutes.

**W**HEREAS it is expedient to provide for the more speedy Preamble.  
Distribution of the Statutes of the Legislature of Canada,  
and for that end, and to amend the Act, 8 Vic., cap. 68 ; Be it  
therefore enacted, &c.,

5 That there shall be appointed by the Governor General, or Persons to be  
person administering the Government of this Province, a person appointed to

10 **II.** That it shall be the duty of the Clerk of the Legislative Such persons

**IV.** That there shall be paid out of the Consolidated Revenue Allowance to  
Fund to the said person so appointed, the sum of *two hundred* such person.  
25 *and fifty pounds* currency, or such other sum as the Governor of  
this Province may think right, for the yearly distribution of the  
Statutes of each Session of Parliament.

**V.** That the Acts reserved for the expression of Her Majesty's As to reserved  
pleasure, and which are distributed separately, shall be distributed Acts.  
30 by post, by Her Majesty's Printer as heretofore by Law pro-  
vided.

**VI.** That the person appointed to distribute the Laws as afore- Security to be  
said, shall give sufficient sureties to Her Majesty for the faithful given.
