An Act to Incorporate the College of Saint Ignatius, Guelph.

WHEREAS, His Lordship, John Farrell, D.D., Roman Catholic Preamble.
 Bishop of Hamilton, John Holzer, John McGuaid, Francis Dumertier and Hector Glackmeyer, have, by their petition, represented to the Legislature that since the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty-five, a College hath been established in the Town of Guelph for the education of youth, and have prayed that corporate powers may be conferred on the said College, and, and in consideration of the great advantages to be derived from the said establishment, it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition. Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows :

1. The said College, which shall be composed of the Roman Catholic Bishop of Hamilton, the Reverend John Holzer, the Reverend John McGuaid, the Reverend Francis Dumertier and the Reverend Hector Certain persons incorporated.
 Glackmeyer, and their successors, together with all such necessary officers as may be hereafter appointed under the provisions of this Act, and their several and respective successors shall be and is hereby constituted, a body politic and corporate in deed and in name, by and under the name of the Corporation of the College of St. Ignatius, Guelph, and by that Corporate name and powers.
 name shall have perpetual Succession and a Common Seal, and shall have power from time to time to alter, renew or change such Common Seal at their pleasure, and shall, by the same name, from time to time and at all times hereafter, be able and capable to purchase, acquire, hold, possess and enjoy, and to have, take and receive to them and their successors, to and for the uses and purposes of the said Corporation, any lands, tenements, hereditaments, and real and immovable property and estate situate, lying and being within this Province, not exceeding in yearly value the sum of exclusive of the buildings erected and to be erected, and the dependencies thereof occupied or hereafter to be occupied by the said Corporation for the purposes thereof, and the same to sell, alienate and dispose of and to purchase others in their stead for the same purpose, and by the said name shall and may be able and capable in law to sue and be sued, implead and be impleaded, answer and be answered unto in all Courts of Law and places whatsoever, in as large, ample and beneficial a manner as any body politic or corporate, or as any person able or capable in law may or can sue or be sued, implead and be impleaded, answer and be answered unto in any matter whatsoever. The Board of Directors of the Corporation for the time being shall have power to frame a constitution for the said Corporation, and to alter the same when it shall be deemed expedient, and to make all such By-laws, Rules and Regulations for the admission into and general management of the said College, not being contrary to this Act or to the laws in force in this Province, as shall be deemed useful or necessary for the interest of the said Corporation, and for the payment of officers and employees, and generally for Corporation may make By-laws, &c.

all purposes relative to the conduct and well working of the Corporation and the management and business thereof, and from time to time to repeal, alter and amend such By-laws, or any of them, and shall have power to appoint such officers and servants as they deem right for the management of the said College, and to remove them at pleasure, and appoint others in their places, and shall and may do, execute and perform all and singular other the matters and things relating to the said Corporation, and the management thereof, or which shall or may appertain thereto, subject nevertheless to the rules, regulations, restrictions and provisions hereinafter prescribed and established.

Proviso.

Application of revenues.

2. Provided always that the rents, revenues, issues and profits of all property, real and personal, held by the said Corporation, shall be appropriated and applied solely to the maintenance of the members of the said Corporation, the construction and repair of the buildings requisite for the purposes of said Corporation, and to the advancement of education by the instruction of youth, and the payment of the expenses to be incurred for objects legitimately connected with or depending on the purposes aforesaid.

Property, &c., of Institution vested in Corporation.

3. All and every the estate and property, real and personal, belonging to or hereafter to be acquired by the members of the said Institution as such, and all debts, claims and rights whatsoever due to them in that quality, shall be and are hereby vested in the Corporation hereby established, and all debts due by them in their said quality shall be paid and discharged by the said Corporation, and the By-laws, Rules, Orders and Regulations now made for the management of the said Institution shall be and continue to be By-laws, Rules, Orders and Regulations of the said Corporation, until altered or repealed in manner herein provided for.

Corporation may appoint officers.

4. The members of the said Corporation, or a majority of them, shall have power to appoint such Attorney or Attorneys, Administrator or Administrators of the property of the Corporation, and such officers, teachers and servants as shall be necessary for the well conducting of the business and affairs thereof, and to allow them compensation for their services, and shall be capable of exercising such other powers and authority for the well governing and ordering of the officers of the said Corporation as shall be prescribed by the By-laws, Rules, Orders and Regulations of the said Corporation.

In case of vacancies.

5. In case of any vacancy occurring in the number of the members of the Board by absence from the Province, death, resignation or otherwise, such vacancy shall and may be filled up from time to time by the remaining members of the said Corporation, within six months after the occurrence of such vacancy or vacancies.

Annual report.

6. It shall be the duty of the said Corporation within fifteen days after the beginning of each session, to lay before each branch of the Provincial Legislature, a detailed statement of the numbers of members of the said Corporation, the number of teachers employed in the various branches of construction, the number of scholars under instruction, and the course of instruction pursued, and of the real or immovable estate of property and of all personal estate or property, producing income or profit held by virtue of this Act, and of the revenue arising therefrom.

Public Act.

7. This Act shall be deemed to be a Public Act.
