An Act to amend the Agricultural Act of Lower Canada, in so far as it affects Water Courses which intersect lines of Railway.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Agricultural Act 20 Vict., Preamble.  
cap. 40: Therefore Her Majesty, &c., enacts as follows :

Section twenty six of the said Act shall hereafter be interpreted as though the following words had been added at the end of the first  
5 paragraph thereof. Sect. 26 of 20 V., C. 40 amended.

“ Provided always, that every railway company shall be bound to make and maintain at its own costs and charges any water course or part of a water course, which now passes or may hereafter pass under or across their railway, or along the line thereof, so as to give free passage to the  
10 water, and in such manner that the water course may be continued as nearly as possible in a straight line and without obstruction.” Proviso added.
