## FIGHTING CONTINUES IN THE BAILLEUL SECTOR.

WITH THE BRITISH ARMY IN FRANCE, April 16.— (By the Associated Press) — Bailleui, eight and a half miles east of Hazebrouck, in Flanders was captured and occupied by the Ger-mans last evening when the enemy also seized Le Revetsberg bigs, east of the town. As a result the British pulled their lines back northward somewhat to positions running east and west a little above Bailleul and Le Revetsberg. Fighting is continuing in this sector with the Germans try-ing to push westward toward the railways centre of Hazebrouck.
