**AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF CANADA AND THE GOVERNMENT  
OF PERU RELATING TO TERMS OF FINANCING FOR THE SALE OF WHEAT  
BY CANADA**

The Government of Canada and the Government of Peru

DESIRING to establish terms of financing for the sale of wheat by Canada to Peru,

Have agreed as follows:

ARTICLE I

The Government of Peru shall buy in Canada, through the Empresa Publica de Servicios Agropecuarios (EPSAP), and Canada shall supply, through the Canadian Wheat Board, up to 280 thousand tons of Canadian wheat, 5% more or less, but not less than 200 thousand tons, 5% more or less, for shipment from Canadian ports during the period July 1, 1970 to June 30, 1971.

ARTICLE II

Under this Agreement, Empresa Publica de Servicios Agropecuarios and the Canadian Wheat Board have concluded a general contract in respect of this transaction. The grades of wheat, delivery terms, prices and other commercial conditions were negotiated and agreed upon by Empresa Publica de Servicios Agropecuarios and the Canadian Wheat Board. Under the terms of this contract, purchases of wheat shall be made by Empresa Publica de Servicios Agropecuarios from an Agent or Agents of the Canadian Wheat Board.

ARTICLE III

The payment terms, which will apply to all shipments made in accordance with Article I, shall be as follows:

A cash payment of five percent of the gross invoice value of each cargo on date of each shipment, and the balance of ninety-five percent payable in equal installments, with the first payment due on the last day of the first year from the date of shipment. Subsequent payments will be due at intervals of six months thereafter, provided final payment will become due not more than three years after date of shipment. Any semi-annual payment may be made in advance. Interest will be payable semi-annually at  $6\frac{1}{4}$  percent per annum, on the principal balance outstanding calculated from date of each shipment.

ARTICLE IV

Notwithstanding current liabilities under policies of insurance issued by the Export Development Corporation, an agency of the Canadian Government, covering previous grain sales to Peru, the Corporation will be authorized to insure at a premium rate of 0.125 percent per annum, ninety-five percent of the gross invoice value, including interest, of each cargo for the first two years from

the Bill of Lading date and thereafter the outstanding balance due on the sum-

ARTICLE I

Le Gouvernement du Pérou achètera au Canada, par l'intermédiaire de  
l'Empresa Publica de Servicios Agropecuarios, et le Canada fournira, par  
l'intermédiaire de la Commission Canadienne du Blé, jusqu'à 280,000 tonnes  
de blé canadien, à cinq pour cent près en plus ou en moins, mais pas moins  
de 200,000 tonnes, à cinq pourcent près en plus ou en moins, la livraison  
devant se faire à partir des ports canadiens, durant la période du 1<sup>er</sup> juillet  
1970 au 30 juin 1971.

ARTICLE II

En vertu du présent accord, l'Empresa Publica de Servicios Agropecuarios  
et la Commission Canadienne du Blé ont conclu un contrat général concernant  
cette transaction. Les qualités de blé, les conditions de livraison, les prix et les  
autres conditions commerciales ont été discutés et approuvés par l'Empresa  
Publica de Servicios Agropecuarios et la Commission Canadienne du Blé. Selon  
les termes de ce contrat, les achats de blé seront faits par l'Empresa Publica de  
Servicios Agropecuarios à un agent, ou à des agents de la Commission Cana-  
dienne du Blé.

ARTICLE III

Les conditions de paiement, qui s'appliqueront à toutes les livraisons  
suivant l'Article I, seront les suivantes:

Un paiement comptant de cinq pour cent du montant brut de la facture  
de chaque livraison, à la date de chaque livraison, et le solde de quatre-  
vingt-quinze pour cent payable en versements égaux, le premier paiement  
étant dû le dernier jour de l'année qui suit la date de la livraison. Les  
paiements subséquents seront payables à intervalles de six mois, à partir  
de ce moment, pourvu que le paiement final soit effectué pas plus tard  
que trois ans après la date de la livraison. Les paiements semestriels  
peuvent se faire à l'avance. L'intérêt se paiera semestriellement à raison  
de 6½ pourcent par an, sur le solde qui reste à payer, à compter de la  
date de chaque livraison.

ARTICLE IV

Nonobstant les obligations courantes, en rapport avec des polices d'as-  
surance émises par la Société de Développement des Exportations, agence du  
Gouvernement canadien, et couvrant des ventes antérieures de blé au Pérou,

ARTICLE VI

The Government of Peru shall not divert to another country any wheat purchased under these arrangements without obtaining prior approval from Canada.

ARTICLE VII

This Agreement shall enter into force on the date of signature.

ARTICLE II

Under this Agreement, Export Services of the Government of Peru shall be provided to the Government of Canada for the purpose of facilitating the export of wheat from Peru to Canada. The Commission shall be composed of representatives of the Government of Peru and the Government of Canada. The Commission shall meet in Ottawa, Canada, on the date of signature of this Agreement. The Commission shall have the authority to make all decisions necessary for the implementation of this Agreement. The Commission shall report to the Government of Peru and the Government of Canada on its activities. The Commission shall be dissolved when the purpose of this Agreement has been achieved.

III ELCTIRA

ARTICLE III

The conditions of payment, as set forth in Article I, shall be as follows: The Government of Peru shall pay to the Government of Canada the outstanding balance due on the purchases made in accordance with the provisions of Article I and in accordance with the terms of payment in Article III.
