In February of last year, troops and vessels of waf were despatched to the scene of the disturbance, and the revolt was suppressed—but not until the blacks had destroyed large amounts of property belonging to the Portuguese, besides several Roman Catholic Churches, and were on the point of proceeding to the commission of further acts of violence. Orr was arrested tried and sentenced to imprisonment at hard labor. He endured this lot until Nevember last, when disease attacked him, which ended his life.
