(Special to the Tribune.) Destructive Fire at St. Andrews—An incendiary at work.

ST. ANDREWS, Aug. 18. There was a destructive fire here last night. The range of buildings on Market Wharf, occupied as stores and dwellings, was destroyed.

When this fire was got under control a second fire broke out in Chase's barn, at the head of King street, outside the town limits. The barn with its contents—some seven tons of hay—was totally consumed. The origin of the second fire was undoubtedly incendiary.

It says the Manitoba settlers are the victims of Minnesota to invade Manitoba and kill cattle, burn crops, and destroy property.

MR. GLADSTONE NOT TO BE RE-ELECTED. Mr. Gladstone has been legally advised that his re-election to Parliament is not required by the assumption of the Chancellorship of the Exchequer.

COAL STRIKE. Several thousand Lancashire coal miners have struck.

CIVIL WAR IN SPAIN. Martene Campos has besieged Cartagena, with 6000 soldiers, two batteries and twelve mortars.

THE CHINA'S SON-IN-LAW. The Imperial family of Russia will assemble formally welcome the Duke of Edinburgh, who goes to St. Petersburg in December. The marriage takes place the following month.

NEW YORK, Aug. 18. NINETY DEAD BODIES of the Wawassett's passengers have been recovered.

ANOTHER RAILWAY SLAUGHTER. On the Chicago and Alton Railroad, 30 miles from Chicago, on Saturday night, a passenger train collided with a coal train, and 11 were killed and 35 wounded.

At New York, 14th inst. John Wallington, the chief surveyor, at New York, was killed by a coal train, who is not among the dead and cannot be found. Among the wounded was John Shearles of Glasgow, Scotland, who is badly hurt and ruptured.
