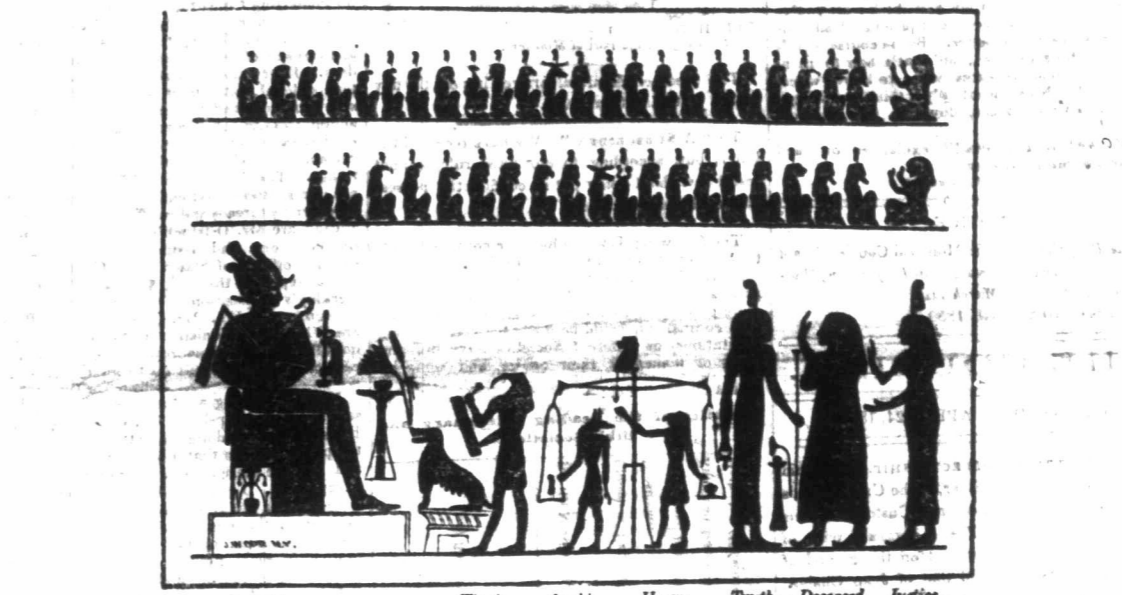

Previously to Napoleon's memorable Campaign in Egypt, 1798-1801, little was known in Europe as to the existence of Papyrus Manuscripts; nothing with respect to the occult significance of the few fragments that had reached the cabinets of scholars. The return of the 'Institut d'Egypte,' followed by the local researches of preserving Antiquaries, Davy, Salt, Boscawen, Brugsma, and others, filled European Museums with long rolls of papyrus and written Papyri; but it was not until after CARPENTIER'S discovery, in 1823, of the method of reading Egyptian characters, that the three forms of writing used by its ancient people were severally distinguished, and the respective tenor of each document in its character satisfactorily made out.
