NEW YORK, March 23.- The Yenian Sr nate continued in session the greater part of to-day, and will probably not adjourn before Tuesday next. No hing positive has transpired regarding their deliberations, but it is well urderstood that preparations for the coming Canadian campaign occupied the principal share of their attention. As yet nothing has come of the negociations in pro-gress looking to the consolidation of the two sections of the organization. The Cork Ezeminer of the 9th, says the insurrection which has seemed to be suppres-ad, has begun again to assume a serious aspect in Limerick and Tipperary, and there were several thousand Fenians in the Galtee Mountains, but they had no means of carry-ing on an offensive war, nor could they hold their ground against an attack. These men have been drawn from their houses, and when collected together, found no provision made to supply them with even the rud-st weapons. Finding ther had been drawn into grave peril without their being a possibility of their serving the cause, numbers of them had re-turned to their homes.
