Eymn Singing.

Commodore Vanderbilt was a sharp, clear, hard, business man, who made a great railroad convenient, comfortable, asfe, and sure for the public, which ought to be grateful for what he did. He sang hymns at the last, and doubtless with sincere emotion. But probably there was not much singing of hymns during the characteristic transactions of his life. "I am glad he liked the hymns," axid Mr. Boscher; "but if he had sung them thirty years ago, it would have made a great difference. He did not sing hymns as long as he could get about." The preacher drew a comparison between the deaths of the Commodore and of Mr. Bliss, the hymnwriter and preacher, who perished in the terrible Ashtabula catastrophe. He said, indeed, that it was not fair to compare the obscure sweet singer of Israel with the famous railway king. But as a Christian moralist he felt that he ought to say how much greater a work in the world the singer seemed to him to have done. He did not sing hymns as long as he could get about. It is true of very many more of us than the Commodore. But it is pleasant to think of those who do: of the men and women who, having no ear for music, are yet singing hymns all the time; of lives that poor and obscure and lonely, are as sweet and inspiring as the loftiest hymns. "Be a good man, my dear," said Walter Scott to his son, as he died. He did not say, be famous, be successful, be conspicuous, be rich. To sing hymns, too, is well, but there is something better; for the one thing of which in this life we may be sure is that a good iffe is a perpetual Te Deum.—Entrox's Magazine for March.
