## BILL.

An Act to define certain Road allowances in the Township of Caledonia.

**W**HEREAS in the survey of the Township of Caledonia, in the county of Prescott, the allowance for Road in all the Concessions except the first, was taken from the front instead of the rear of the said Concessions as by law required, and in consequence of such irregularity doubts have arisen as to which end of the several Concession lines the Road should be taken from, and it is expedient to define the same: Be it therefore enacted, &c. Preamble.

10 And it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That notwithstanding the error which has occurred in the said survey and return, the posts planted at the front angles of the lots in all the Concessions of the said Township, except the first, respectively, shall be held to be their unalterable boundaries, and the allowance for Road shall be Road allowances in Caledonia defined.
