REMARKS

W. SCOTT & SON beg to submit their Ninth Annual Catalogue of Original Paintings, being, as usual, their own selection, and mostly direct purchases from the Artists.

Upon an examination of the works herein enumerated it will be noticed that this collection is a vast improvement on any previous ones.

There are no less than four artists represented in this Catalogue who have received all the honors and medals that are given by the Paris Salons, and have also been decorated with the Legion of Honor by the French Government, viz., Messieurs Pelouse, Lansyer, Vernier and Wyld, while several of the younger men have received honorable mention and third and second class medals. Frithjof Smith-Hald, a young Norwegian artist, has already received distinguished honors from some of the prominent Galleries in Europe. Several of his fine coast scenes having been reproduced in Photo-Gravure by Goupil of Paris.

As these pictures are of a high order of merit, and very costly, W. Scott & Son are reserving the right of one bid on a few of the most important ones, but in every case the limit is considerably below what they would be sold for at private sale.

The principal object in submitting to public sale works of this class is to test the range of this market, and see if it is prudent to continue to import them.
