The Government of Newfoundland have decided
augment the pay of Newfoundland Royal Naval to augment the pay of Newfound the
Reservists so as to place them on the same footing as en of the Newfoundland Regiment.
Under the provision of the War Measure Act, authority is given to the Minister of Militia to deal with
the matter of augmentation of pay of the Royal Naval Naval Officer, St. John's.

It is ordered that a sum of 33 c . per day be placed commencement of the war, in cases where men were
 services began up to the time of discharge, or
or to the 30th of September, 1917, inclusive.
As the rate of pay of Naval Reservists was inbetween the amount they receive and that allowed the members of The Royal Newfoundland Regiment is from that date.
The foregoing amounts will not in any case be ister of Militia, St. John's, Nfil., is solely responsible
for the issue of any sums due. in any of H. M. Ships, including all members of the

(b) Payment will be made to the nominee of any

(c) Sums due will be placed to the credit of Re-
sesrve men who do not desire to avail themselves of the foregoing and can be drawn by them at the ex-
piration of their service.

All communications of any description with rePayment will commence on 1st May, 1918.

In cases where members of the Royal Naval Re serve (Newfoundland) have been killed in action or
died of wounds or sickness, or through any other cause, the amount due as Augmentation Pay will go tain the Estate of the deceased is, in case of a Will, Letters of Probate; and in case there is not a wiil, Let-
ters of Administration. Such letters are issued by the Supreme Court of Newfoundland on the Petition and
Proosf of Executor of the Will, or the next of kin. If
