Editor World: Just a word, Mr. Shaw!

Let me whisper to you, Mr. Fleming!

Toronto is the leading city in Ontario.

Other towns and cities look to Toronto.

Remember, there is a whole continent of Ontario to be developed.

We have no railway communication into the territory.

Montreal and Ottawa have railway communication with that country.

Montreal and Ottawa, therefore, get the trade.

Hundreds of thousands of dollars of trade go out of Ontario to Toronto.

Not a dollar comes out of Ontario to Toronto.

The future Mayor of Toronto should pledge himself to work with other Ontario towns and cities and find a way into northern Ontario.

Open up the Temiscamincue country.

We want the Toronto and James Bay railway.

This will give us an opening into the great mining and lumbering districts of northern Ontario.

The new country will provide homes and work for thousands.

Pledge yourselves that you will co-operate with other towns. Urge the Federal and Local Governments to increase their subsidies from \$5000 to \$12,000 a mile. Then the road will be built.

Don't allow Toronto to be side-tracked.

Toronto is out of the race just now.

Read last Saturday's World and sort yourselves about the Temiscamincue country.

All the land east and west is settled.

G.T.B. Coal Experiments.

The tests to obtain a suitable coal for the engines of the G.T.B. service, which have been conducted with coal brought from 20 miles, for more than a month, between the stations of Little York and Belleville, are now finished.

A specially conducted and exhaustive experiment, which took five hours each day to record the wind's velocity, the atmosphere's pressure and the difference in resistance made by cattle and box cars, etc. It will be some months yet before the decision is arrived at.

The appointment of the deputy reeves as commissioners, whereby the council has been brought into closer touch with the township.
