## Hiftorical Chronicle, <br> October

Extract of a lettcr from Chebucto barbour, Nova Scotia, Auguf 17.
 Fter the feveral viciffitudes of fortune, I am arrived at this new fettlement, which far exceeds any idea I could poffibly have of it. At our firt landing in thisharbour, which is the fineft Iever faw in the world, we fourd the place on each lide ar entire wood, upon a gradual declivity to the fhore, the trees large and flanding clofe together, and light fern growing between, the paffage not interrupted with thorns and briars,as the European woods are, and furnifhed with delicate fprings of water. The air is very temperate, and I believe exceeding healthful. This is the hotteft part of the fummer; the mornings and evenings are delightfully pleafant, and the middle of the day not warmer than I have found it in England. Every body arrived at prefent have excellent appetites, from the good temperament of the air ; which puts me in mind of Italy, and I think there is a good profpeet of its being altogether as fertile, and in time as enchanting to its inhabitants. The foil is of the fineft mould I ever faw, capable of producing any thing; and I ancy much lefs difficulty will be met with in clearirg the woods than was expected; for about two miles from the water-fide, at the fummit of the hill, the trees are in general very fmall, and at a diftance from each other ; where there is fine fhooting, viz. plenty of partridges, pigeons, hares, rabbits, and $a$ fort of black game that we meet with in fome parts of England. I have dined upon a porcupine, that is as delicious as a young fawn: whether I may venture to do fo on a bear I know not: Some of the people have caught feveral young ones. The harbour abounds with fifh of feveral forts, lobiters and mackrel in great quantities, and other fimall finh in abundance. There are feveral frefh rivers well fored with fine falmon; which many have experienced, and brought great quantities down to our new town of Halifax: But the abfolute neceffity of every one's affilting in clearing the ground, does, for the prefent, divert them from the employments of fifhing and fhooting, and obliges us to be fatisfied with what a few Indians fupply us with, who come fre-
quently to us in their canoes, at reafon able rates.

There is an ifland fituated at the entrance of the harbour, where a fortification, I apprehend, will be built, and will not be unlike the wooden fort at the entrance of the Tigus. We have had various rumours about the number had various rumours about the number tlement; but I give no credir to it, for I am fatisfied we have fufficient force to protect us. The governor has got the hearts of the pcople, by amiable deportment, and has taken care of their healths, and fubfiftence as far as polfible, and to render an uninhabited place as conve nient to them as is in his power: However, many difficulties muft be encountered with in the infancy of luch an undertaking. We lie in tents, and the great fogs, frequent in this place, render it fometimes uncomfortable ; but I do not find it prejudicial to our healths. The rain falls here pretty heavy; but tho' we are wet thro' our little fortifica tions, yet it is not attended with any cold fhivering or diforders whatfocver. The winter is what we have to fear: D from good intelligence it is very fevere, and of long continuance, and we are making preparations for our fecurity againft that inclement feafon.
The townhhip is laid out, and an allotment of ground is given to every family ; the fingle people mix togethcr as they approve themfelves. We hope we fhall be able to preferve ourfelves from the feverity of the weather, by litule boarded huts ; but it is fear'd much hard. thip muft be endured, the fummer being too far advanced to do great things this year. The little knowledge 1 have obtained, in the fhort time we have been here, of the uifefulnefs of the place F to England, fatisfies me, that thole gentlemen who firft propofed this colony, and have fo zealoully ferved their country thereby, will reap immortal honour for having fo fingularly dittinguifhed themfelves, and in time will be the authors of the happinefs of others, who might have lived ufelefs and died miferable at home. Many things to forward the fuccefs of this undertaking muft be done by parliament ; but every body is fo well latisficd with the gentleman that governs them, that they have no doubt but proper remonftrances will come from him, who thews the greatel tendernefs for thicir welfare: And the
