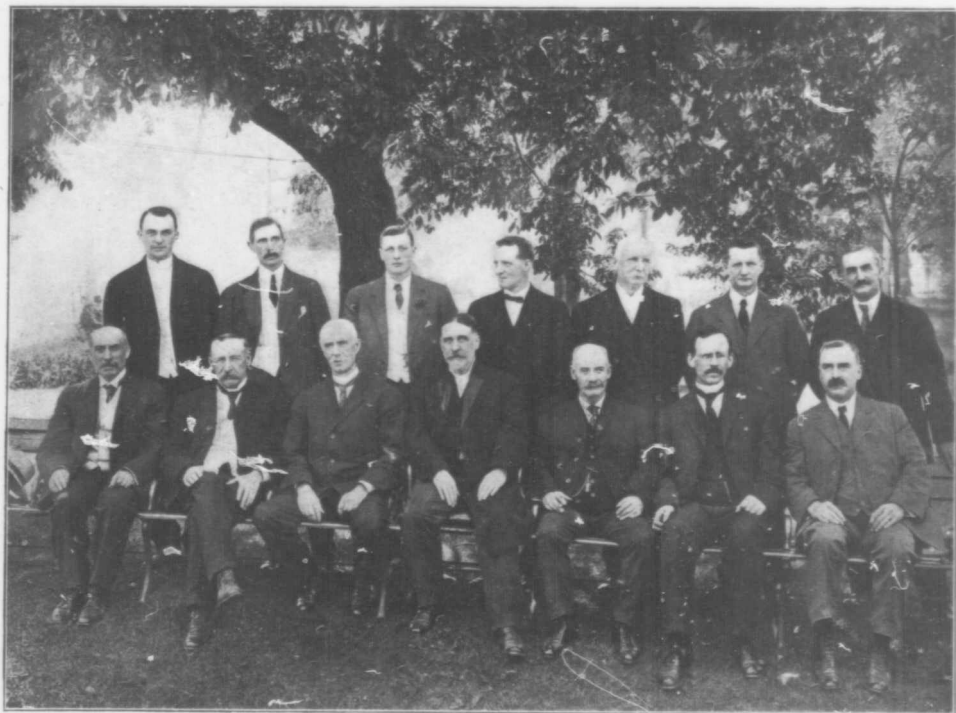

THE location of St. John in the centre of population in the Maritime Provinces makes it the best and cheapest distributing point for merchandise of every description,

☞ St. John has direct steamship connections all the year round with London, Glasgow and Manchester in Great Britain; with all the principal ports in the British West Indies; with Cuba and Porto Rico; with Eastport, Portland and Boston; with Digby, Yarmouth, Liverpool, Shelburne and Halifax and Bay of Fundy Ports in Nova Scotia.

☞ During the season of open navigation on the St. John River, steamboats run regularly to all points between St. John and Fredericton, the Grand Lake, the Washademoak, the Bellisle and the Kennebecasis.

☞ St. John is the Atlantic terminus of the Canadian Pacific Railway and of the Intercolonial Railway. With their branches these railways reach every important town in the Province. New territory is being opened up by the National Trans-Continental now under construction.

☞ St. John has an area of 21 square miles and an estimated population of 47,500. It has 52 miles of streets. The assessed value of taxable property is \$30,000,000. The corporation owns the harbor, the water system, the public markets and ferry system besides large blocks of real estate, the total value of which is \$7,000,000. The total revenue of the city from all sources averages \$1,000,000 a year.

☞ The exports from St. John total \$25,000,000 annually. The coasting trade has increased from 349,545 tons in 1900 to 764,682 tons in 1910. The Bank clearings have increased from \$66,435,636 in 1908 to \$77,843,540 in 1910. St. John is growing in manufactures and Trade every season.

☞ *The completion of the Grand Trunk Pacific and the St. John Valley Railways will make St. John the Atlantic Terminus of three Trans-continental railway systems and the most important port east of New York.*

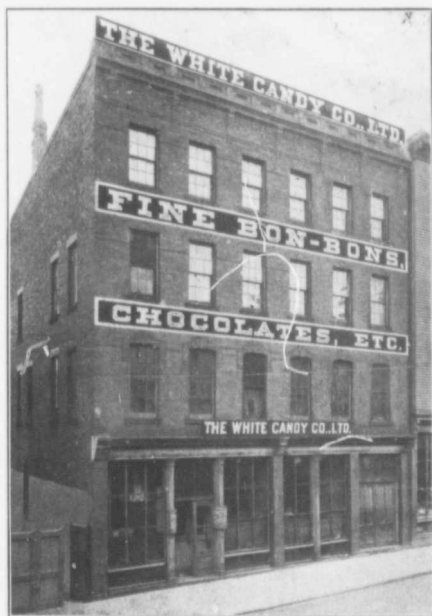

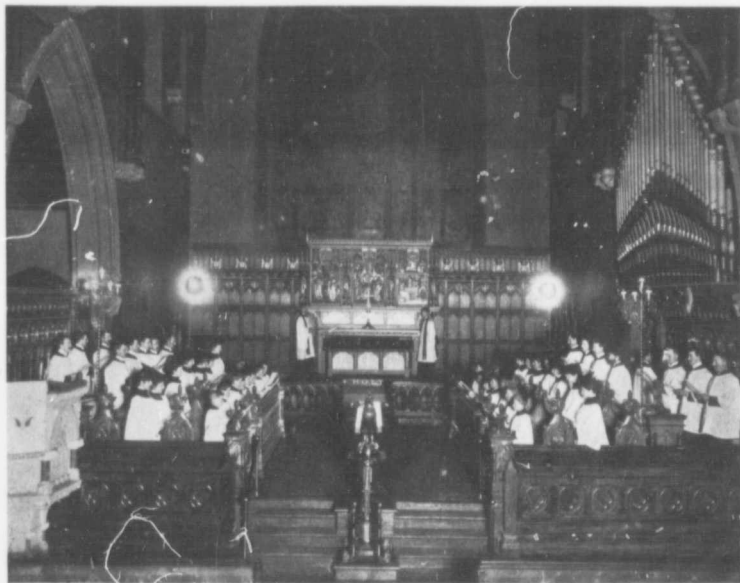

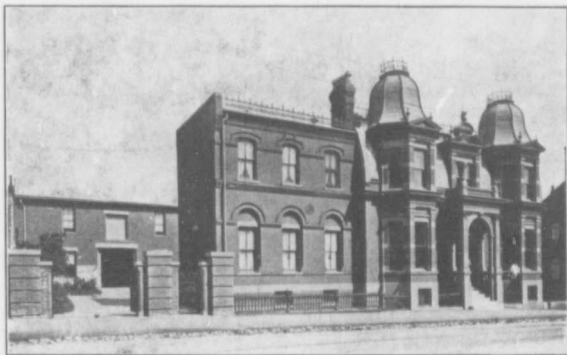

President and Council of the Board of Trade, 1910.



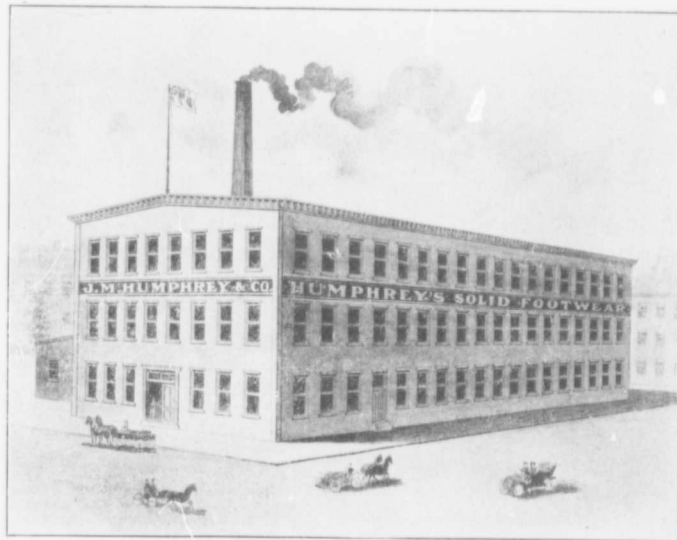

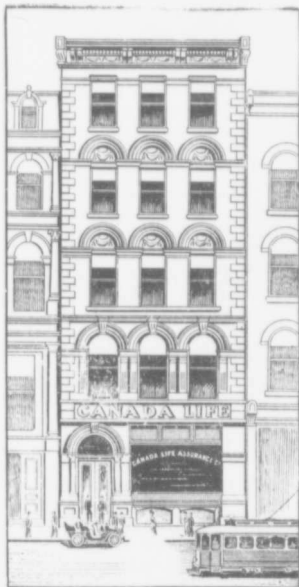

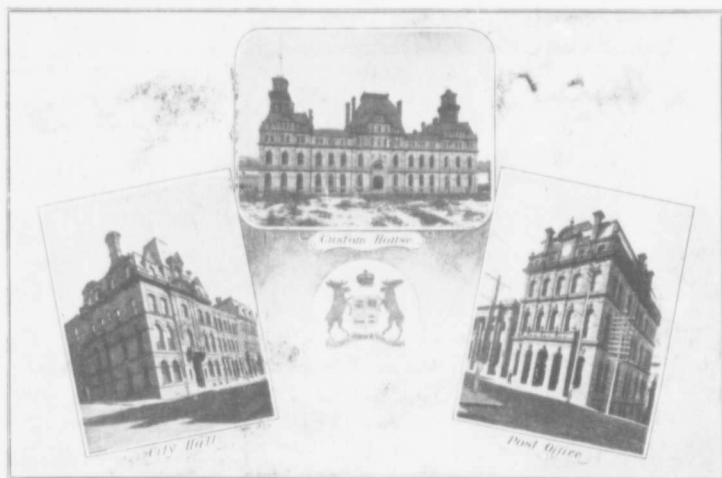

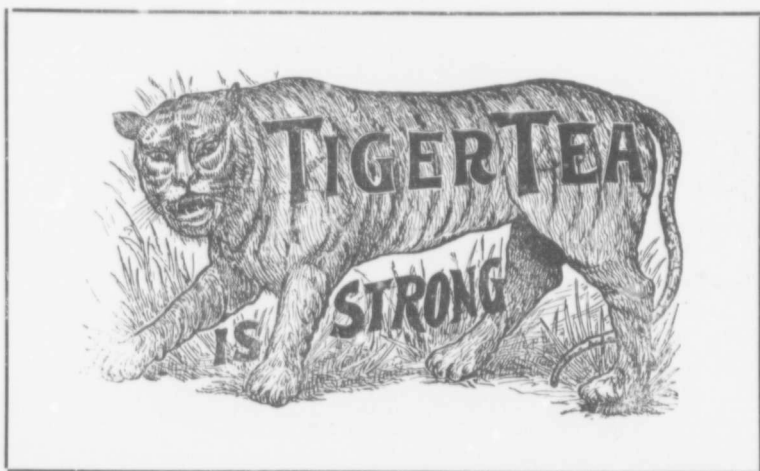

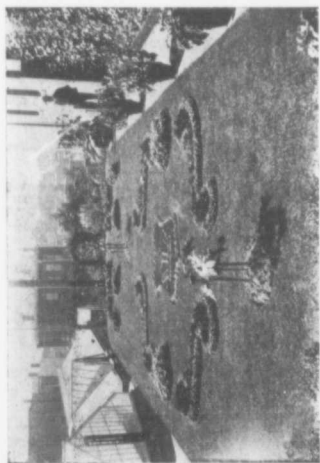

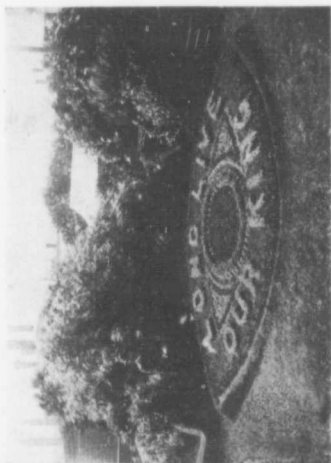

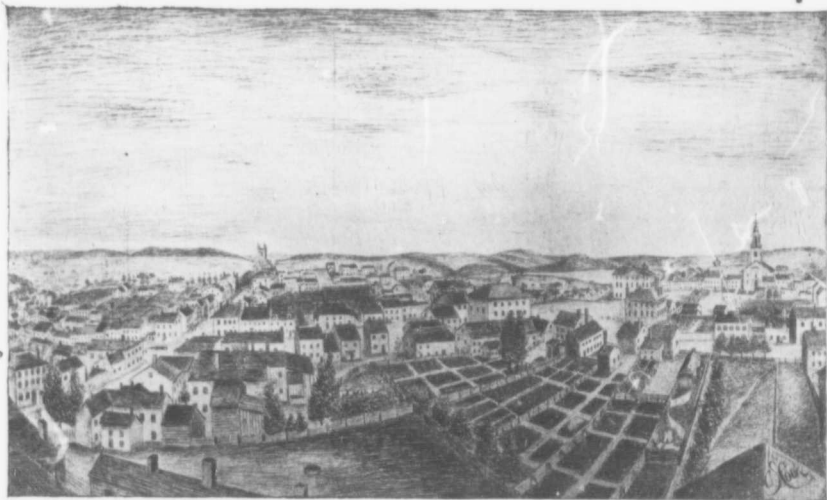

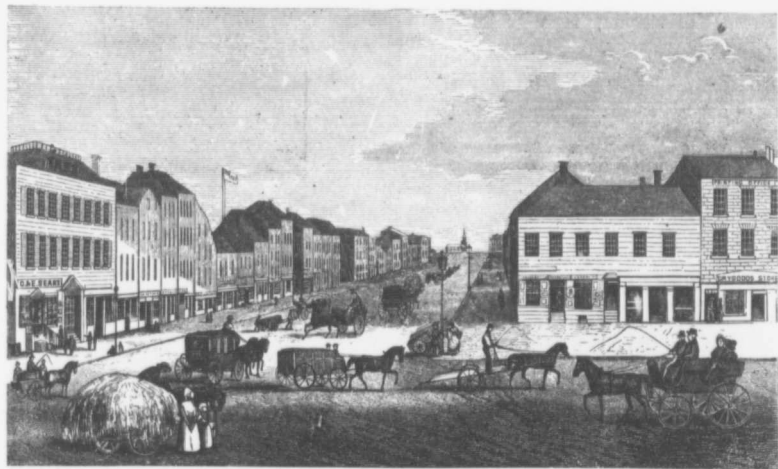

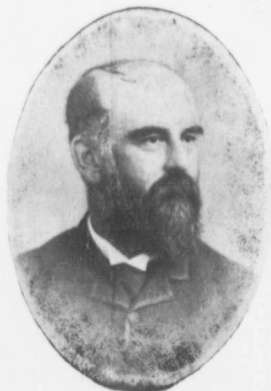

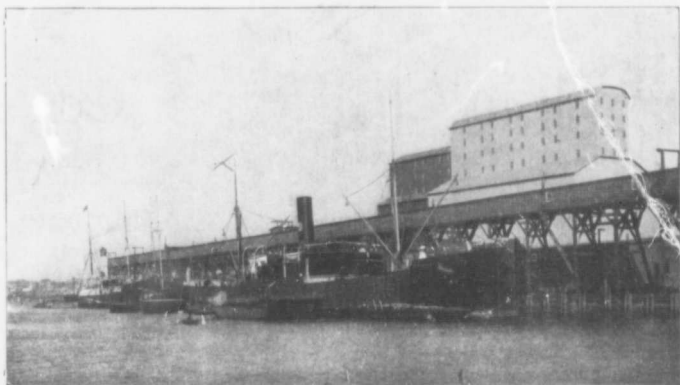

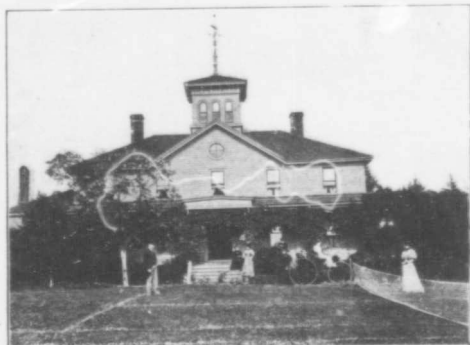

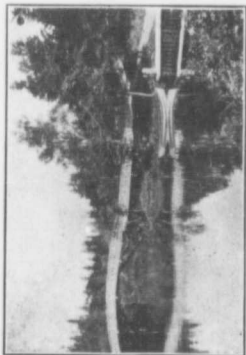
