ANNAPOLIS, N. S.

In the Municipal Council, Semi-Annual Meeting, 1883.

Council met in the Court House, Bridgetown, on Tuesday, the 1st day of May, A. D., 1883.

Present, the Warden and Councillors: Mearns, Roscoe, Leonard, Vidio, Young, Kennedy, Clarke, Ross, Whitman, Bent, Oakes, Charlton, Dukeshire and Buckler. Councillor Mills was absent from the presence on the first three days of the Council.

The return of the Deputy Prising Officer for Ward No. 1st, having been filed, William Charlton was duly sworn into office as Councillor for Ward No. 1st.

Ordered, That the Lunatic Asylum accounts be referred to the committee on finance.

Upon reading and considering the petition of S. L. Tilley, and others, asking to have George Kelly placed in the statute labor district to which he formerly belonged, it is ordered, That the prayer thereof be granted, and that the return of the Council in reference thereto, at the last annual meeting, be rescinded, and that the bonds of said district remain established by law.

Upon reading and considering the petition of the five Warden of the town, praying to be allowed to assess the five districts of Bridgetown, for fire purposes, it is ordered, That the prayer of said petition be granted, and that said district be allowed to assess itself in the sum of \$250.

Assessors, F. C. Harris, John E. Murdoch and Warrant Dodge. Rescess.

Ordered, That the tender for the collection of rates in Ward No. 3, be considered as an ungratified rate.

Ordered, That a new bond for the collection of rates for Ward No. 1, be prepared, and forwarded to Councillor Mearns for execution by the proper parties.

Upon reading and considering the report of the Committee on Tenders and Public Property, the same was on motion adopted. The following is the report:—

To the Warden and Members of the Municipal Council, in Council convened:— We the undersigned, your committee on tenders and public property, beg leave to submit the following report:—

During the month of February, following, the Annual Meeting of Council, we were directed to purchase a site of land for a Poor Property in the County of Annapolis, in the name of Wallace Morgan, of Bear River, in the County of Annapolis, for the sum of one thousand dollars.

This site was not effected until the month of March last, and upon the following terms:— Two hundred dollars down, three hundred and one, two, and three, to the satisfaction of your committee, at the end of which time, a deed is to be given to the said Wallace Morgan, and a charge given to the Municipality for the unexpired portion of the term.

We made a careful search of the records of the County touching the rights of the Municipality to Ferry accommodations on the Annapolis side of the river, and while in the said search, we discovered a deed under the title grant, a ferry slip was recovered out of said conveyance, and the same was and are therefore unable to tell the width of said slip property, on the Annapolis side.

We caused notice to be posted in the various wards, calling for tenders for the collection of rates, and awarded the collection of said rates, to the parties mentioned in the paper annexed hereto, marked "A." It is gratifying to us to be able to report, that out of the total sum of \$14,423.63 has been received, and an average percentage of a little more than 41 per cent. has been received. We awarded the printing to Mr. Piper, for \$35.00, his being the only tender.
