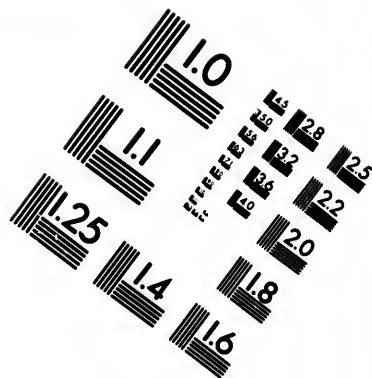
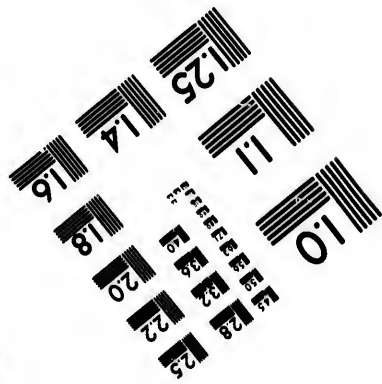
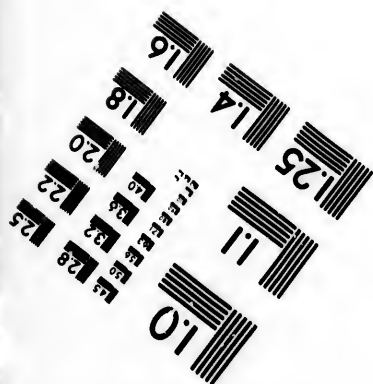




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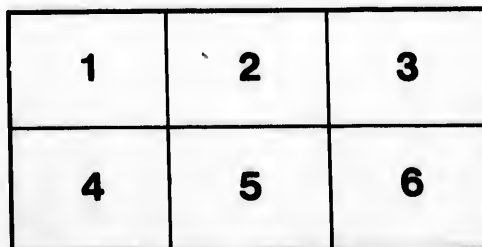
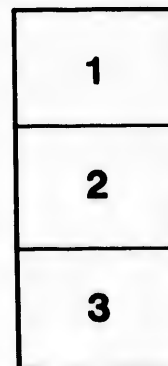
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The part should be first fomented with warm water, then wipe dry, rub in the fluid freely, and take a spoonful, in a little syrup or warm water, three or four times a day. Three Dandelion Pills should also be taken every night before going to bed.

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Rub the chest, lungs, and soles of the feet with the Fluid before going to bed, and take from one to three teaspoonfuls in a little warm water or sugar, or sweet milk.

FOR SORE THROAT :

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Take a teaspoonful in half a tumbler of cold water, and rub the fluid on the crown of the head.
