HYACINTHE, IBERVILLE and BEAUBARNOIS, &c. to be heard and determined at the Court of QUEBEC only, and the writs in such cases are returnable there; and cases in Appeal from the Districts of THREE RIVERS, QUEBEC, SAGUENAY (now divided into two Districts, SAGUENAY and CHICOUTIMI), GASPE, RIMOUISE, KAMOURASKA, MONTGASPE, BEAUCHE and ARTHABASKA are to be heard and determined at the Court of QUEBEC only, and the writs in such cases are returnable there.
