During the year ending 30th November, 1885, the names of 21 new members were added to the Roll, and the Society has had to regret the loss by death in the same time of but one member, our late respected President, James Graham, Esquire.

The quarterly meetings were regularly held, not one meeting during the year having been adjourned for want of a quorum. Nothing has happened in the history of the Society during the year calling for special mention, unless it be the movement for obtaining a new burial plot in Mount Pleasant Cemetery, which is now on the point of completion.

At the close of the year Mr. Allan Cassels, who has been Secretary for four consecutive years, tendered his resignation of that office. His faithful services for so long a period well merited the hearty vote of thanks that was tendered him. The Annual Sermon was preached on the evening of Sunday, 29th November, in St. Andrew's Church, by the Rev. D. J. Macdonnell, to a crowded congregation. The collection amounted to \$70. St. Andrew's Day was celebrated enthusiastically by a dinner

at the Queen's Hotel, which passed off with the uniform success that has hitherto characterized all celebrations of the Day in Toronto.

The Managers' and Treasurer's Reports are appended, as also a list of things belonging to the Society, as instructed by the meeting held on 12th February last.

### MANAGERS' REPORT.

Your Managers in submitting to you the Annual Report of their Stewardship, would state that they have drawn more liberally upon the Treasury, and that their expenditure is considerably in excess of the previous year.

Part of this increased expenditure has been on account of our having to provide for four burials—and in this connection we would inform the Society that our Burial Plot in the Necropolis is full, and you will be called upon at this meeting to secure a suitable plot in Mount Pleasant Cemetery.

We have, during the current year, issued 121 orders for amounts from 50 cts. to \$25.00, the total amount expended by your Managers being \$410.25. In all cases submitted to our consideration, we have endeavoured, when possible, to thoroughly investigate the statements made by the applicants for relief, and although we are occasionally deceived by very plausible tales of *distress*, yet we think such cases have been very few, and we prefer in doubtful cases to give charity the benefit of the doubt. To be perfect is Divine ; to err is human.

Our aim in assisting the friendless has always been to help them to help themselves, as we believe that the more we can foster the spirit of independence, the natural

instinct of our race, so much the sooner will those we help become self-reliant, and able not only to help themselves but to assist others.

In many cases we have succeeded in obtaining employment for those able and willing to work, and would tender our sincere thanks to our President, also to Allan Cassels, Angus McKay, Alex. McMillan and Wm. Henderson, who have kindly assisted us in this pleasing duty, and we would respectfully ask all members requiring any kind of labor during the coming winter, to leave their name, address and requirements with the Secretary or any of your new Managers. We have also to thank Drs. Thorburn and Ross for their ready and kindly assistance in all cases of sickness, and they will receive their reward, when the Great Physician will say unto them, "Inasmuch as ye have done it unto one of these, my brethren, ye have done it unto me."

In conclusion we would state that we have relieved over 400 persons, and that many thankful hearts have reason to bless St. Andrew's Society for very timely aid in their hour of need.
