DEFINITE OFFER TO BUILD ASSURES VALLEY RAILROAD IF HAZEN DOES HIS DUTY

Thomas Malcolm's Letter, Withheld by Government at Fredericton, is Given to People by Mr. Tweeddale—It Gives the Information the Residents of Province Want—Plan Business Proposition in Black and White

Fredericton, N. B., March 15.—When at the close of his splendid speech on the subject yesterday, A. H. Tweeddale, M. P., for Victoria county, made the announcement that Premier Hazen had in his possession a bona fide offer to construct the Valley Railway, and had refused to give that information to the house and country.

Dear Sir:—On behalf of the Quebec and New Brunswick Railway Company, the charter of which has been granted by parliament with power to construct and equip a railway from Quebec to St. John, I hereby offer to enter into a contract to construct the portion from Grand Falls to St. John, the line when so constructed and equipped to be leased to the government of Canada and operated as part of the Intercolonial system, pursuant to the proposed legislation which the Dominion government has submitted to parliament.

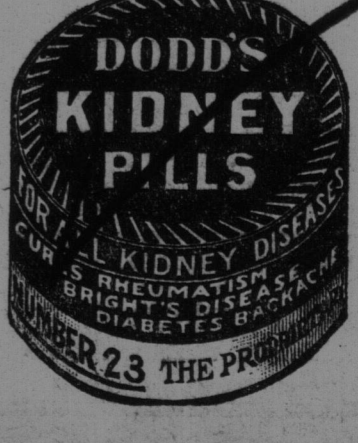

was the most important question before the people of New Brunswick. He was confident now that the St. John Valley Railway can be built in connection with such an important undertaking, and without costing the province one cent for interest. In reaching history of the great project, Mr. Tweeddale showed how earnestly Dr. Pugsley had, when in the legislative assembly, pushed the bill for the construction of the road. He had been the first to place a bond guarantee upon the statute book to secure such an important undertaking, and had offered \$15,000 per mile in this way to encourage the construction of the Valley road. But no one was willing to undertake the work then. Since this government came into power that offer had been increased, because the public demand became greater, more insistent, because there were delegations from one end of the valley to the other demanding its construction. Further than that, the people knew that the splendid efforts put forth by F. B. Carvell to have the Transcontinental come down the valley had failed because of the demands from Nova Scotia for a short route across country. He paid a warm tribute to Carvell's efforts to have the railway built for the people of the St. John valley.

Mr. Hazen offered A. H. Gould, whom every one knew to be closely associated with the Canadian Pacific projects. In that scheme there was nothing to safeguard the interests of the people of the province, nothing to ensure the road's operation, and when Mr. Gould had made the question of building a bridge across the harbor. Mr. Sweeney presented petitions of the city council of Moncton in favor of a bill to amend their act of incorporation; also in favor of a bill relating to the inspection of buildings. Mr. Tweeddale presented a petition in favor of a bill to amend the act of incorporation of Andover. Mr. Robinson presented a petition of the city council of Moncton in favor of a bill to authorize the sale of the contagious diseases hospital. Mr. Burchell, in the absence of the solicitor general, submitted the report of the standing rules committee. Mr. Robinson presented the petition of J. S. Magee, city clerk of Moncton, in favor of several bills prepared and introduced by the city council of Moncton. Mr. Tweeddale introduced a bill to amend the act incorporating Maine & New Brunswick Electrical Power Co. Ltd. Hon. Attorney General introduced a bill to incorporate the Atlantic Trust Co. Hon. Mr. Maxwell presented a petition from the citizens of St. John in favor of a bill to exempt the York and Cornwall cotton mills from taxation. Hon. Mr. Maxwell submitted the report of the Halifax School for the Blind. The house adjourned at 5.30.
