The Banking Bill Sharply Criticized. A Government Sink Hole-The Main Estimate Passed.

Ottawa, Wednesday, April 23. In the Commons today Mr. Patterson (Essex) introduced a bill amending the Bank Act, permitting of the leasing of expensive machinery as well as the sale, a principle, he said, adopted in England and the States.
