

Capital City Motorists Ranked Best In Country

A survey released in Ottawa by the Federal Department of Transport says that Frederictonians are the best drivers in Canada. The survey was compiled from data collected by departmental spies located in every major city in Canada. Fredericton's previous

rank was sixth. Fredericton drivers outperformed drivers in other cities in many categories, including an excellent score in proper signalling techniques. "This result is very promising. I've been told for years that Fredericton drivers are very bad, when in fact the opposite is true," said Mayor Broad Woodshed. He said City Council has plans for

a 'Driver Appreciation Day,' complete with free car washes and no traffic enforcement. "Drivers will be able to 'forget' to signal when turning. Also, blindly changing lanes will be allowed," said the Mayor. Fredericton drivers did very well in yielding the right-of-way, according to the survey. One of three drivers yielded properly at four-way in-

tersections. Another category in which city drivers outperformed other cities was driving with their headlights on. Fredericton drivers in general had their headlights on at least two hours after sundown, outdone only by drivers in Yellowknife, Northwest Territories, where sundown rarely occurs. Since the release of the survey,

Fredericton City Hall has been swamped with calls from interested traffic controllers from as far away as Vancouver, who are curious to know the secrets passed on by generations of Frederictonians. Woodshed is overjoyed. He said he himself learned from his father when he was sixteen, in an old Chevy truck his father had learned from his grandfather before that in

an old Ford Truck. "This ranking will definitely put Fredericton on the map. We've been driving here for a long, long time. We know we're good, now we have something to brag about." *Editor's Note: The previous article is obviously a heaping load of bullshit. Fredericton drivers really suck. Fredericton To Get \$10B Subway

Fredericton mayor Broad Woodshed has revealed plans for the construction of a 10-billion dollar high-speed subway in Fredericton.

To be called the 'Fredericton Express,' the subway system will span from the airport to Tim Horton's on the Woodstock Road, with expansion routes to come at a later date. Construction should be completed sometime in 1996.

"It's the next step in reinforcing Fredericton's position as a world leader in public transportation," said Mayor Woodshed at a Fredericton Transit press conference.

The main subway line will run in a circular pattern around the city, with stops at all the malls, two at the university, and two downtown. An additional train will be built to travel linearly from the airport, along the river, to one of the downtown stops, likely at King's Place.

Mayor Woodshed expects construction to begin immediately, providing employment for approximately 200 labourers, or out-of-work miners from Minto, to dig the 60-metre-diameter tunnels.

Fredericton Transit's 50 busdrivers will be the first offered positions driving the subway cars when the line opens.

"Now we can sleep at the wheel while we drive. After all, we don't have to steer these newfangled subway cars," said Dermott McNutt, a veteran busdriver.

Meanwhile, the city's taxi drivers are not taking the news lightly. They feel that they may lose their jobs if the use of taxis decreases.

"What we'll try to do is keep the fares down, probably at a level in direct competition with the subway," said Ron Grunt, president of the Fredericton Taxi Driving Collective.

Other drivers, who wished to remain anonymous, are considering gaining short-term employment with the city in constructing the new subway.

"Hell, at least I'll be doing something to make me busy enough to stop smoking all the time. Besides, getting people from point A to point B efficiently is what I do best," one driver said.

Money for the construction will come from both the city and provincial governments, as both have many employees who can use the system.

It is rumoured that Premier Frank McSpella himself is pushing hard for the completion of this project, as his private home is located along one of the proposed routes. The Office of the Premier refused to return any calls.

Fares for the first two years of the subway's operation have been set at one dollar a ride, or \$35 for a monthly 'Express' pass, which would be a photo-ID card.

The construction contract has been awarded to Woodrot & Weakcment of Fredericton, who submitted the lowest bid to City Hall. If recalled, that is the same company who designed and constructed the elegant Lowfood building on Queen Street, which has been called a "Temple to the Architectural Gods."

A spokesperson for the construction firm, Randy Bockmon, said the company is ready to begin construction any day now.

"We are very honoured to have been awarded such a large contract on such little proof of the quality of our work. We will try our best to build the fine citizens of Fredericton a really nice subway."

The mayor is confident in his choice of contractors.

"I buy my groceries at Lowfood. I like the building personally," he said.

The Gleaner will keep all of our readers updated on the construction progress so you don't have to get off your couch and go out and see for yourself. Cabbies Have Military Weapons

Those holes in your taxi aren't necessarily rust anymore. The Fredericton Taxi Driving Collective has taken matters into its own hands—tired of waiting for City Council to act, the drivers have taken to arming their vehicles with surplus military weaponry.

Renaming themselves AUTO (Armed Urban Taxi-drivers Organization), these militant drivers have begun to systematically hunt down and terminate anyone attempting to breach the Fare Agreement of last month.

"We said we would be self-policing—we weren't kidding. Step out of line, and your ass is grass," said Rambo Slant, president of AUTO.


Skirmishes over fares have already broken out in front of the SUB and the Malls, where students traditionally call several taxis and leave with the first to arrive. Tensions have flared over this, with

Gorbachev Has Birthmark Removed

MOSCOW (Goiter) - Former Soviet President Mikhail Gorbachev underwent a three-hour operation yesterday to remove the characteristic birthmark on his forehead above his left eye.

The operation occurred at Moscow General Hospital and was performed by Dr. Stanley Robinson, the American plastic surgeon who lightened the skin of pop-superstar Michael Jackson.

TOKYO (EP) - A noted Tokyo-based journalist is interested in being the UNB Student Union's new administrator.

Former SU President John Bostitch plans to apply for the job in the next few days, *The Dairy Creamer* has learned.

"I'm definitely interested in this newly-created position because I have first-hand experience," said Bostitch in an interview from his Tokyo condominium.

"Since my untimely departure from the Student Union I have learned a few new things and gained some experience which the Student Union could benefit from," said Bostitch, who for the last three years has been covering the Tokyo Stock Exchange for a leading Japanese newspaper.

"I believe my contacts and knowledge of the stock and money markets could be helpful as the university and the Student Union embark on a major fundraising drive to expand the Student Union Building," he said. "I've learned a few things about how to manage money and how to get the most value for it. The Japanese are wonderful teachers in this regard."

In addition, Bostitch says he has learned a great deal about the media during his tenure in Japan.

"I hope to improve relations between the Student Union and the student media. Should I be appointed by the Selection Committee I believe I have the oral and written communication skills necessary to project a positive image for the Student Union," he said.

Despite differences of opinion with certain senior university officials in the past, Bostitch says that's all water under the bridge now.

"I'm fully prepared to work co-operatively and effectively with all university administrators for the benefit of the Student Union and the students," said Bostitch.

News that Bostitch is interested in the Administrator's job has been met with a little less enthusiasm by university officials. The university's Vice-President Finance and Administration Jim Sullivan says he will have to live with the appointment if that is what the Student Union's Selection Committee decides.

"It's like dealing with the student media," said Sullivan. "They're there so we have no choice but to deal with them."

At least one other university administrator is being less diplomatic than Sullivan. Student Union Building Director Kim Norisk says the Bostitch appointment would not be welcomed by him.


"It would just sour relations between this office and the SU. It's hard for my mind to imagine just how this could possibly take place," concluded Morris.

Conference to Examine Mating Habits of Gerbils

An upcoming conference to be held from April 30, to May 2, 1994 at the WU Conference Centre will examine such topics, among others, as the effects of loud music on the mating habits of domesticated gerbils.

Sponsored by the UNB Department of Extension and Needless Personal Development, the conference will be the first of its kind in Canada.

Four renowned international experts on gerbils and their mating habits will be the guest speakers for the four-day event.

As well, gerbil lovers of all ages will be invited to take part in a gerbil mating awareness session on Saturday, May 2 at 9:00am. There will be a gerbil clown for the children and parents are encouraged to bring a pot-luck dish which includes gerbil food as one of its major ingredients. Children are asked to bring a toilet-paper tube to give to the gerbils for fodder.

One guest speaker, Dr. Daniel DeDouceur, will speak on the ef-

fects of loud music on the mating habits of domesticated gerbils. He thinks that under certain circumstances, gerbils will keep their rhythm in sync with the music they are mating to.

"For example, I've found that those little buggers take a liking to music with a lot of rhythm, like Bob Marley or something. Their litters, as a result, tend to be slightly more numerous and they produce relatively larger offspring," said Dr. DeDouceur.

Other speakers include Reverend Louis Parter, who will speak upon the ethics of mating sibling gerbils. Is it creating a breed of unhealthy, low gene-pooled animals?

"Personally, I wouldn't want to mate with my sister. I mean, she's pretty enough I guess. And her figure's not too bad, but I'd feel pretty guilty. So think of those poor little horny gerbils. They're all dressed up with nowhere to go, if you see my reference," said Reverend Parter.

Dr. Kay Reality has spent the bulk of her adult life examining gerbils in the wild. She is the author of the best-seller, "How Gerbils Keep Sand Out of Their Fur." She will

read an excerpt of the book that made her known the world over as the "Gerbil Lady."

"Before mating, gerbils will lick each others fur to rid them of any grits of sand which may impede their mating enjoyment. This doubles, of course, as a form of gerbil foreplay," she explained.

Since 1975, gerbils have become one of the more popular pets for Canadians. These loveable, easy-to-keep animals survive for days on little water or food, and recycle toilet-paper tubes to make their nests from.

Gerbils have, until recently, been unknown to North Americans. They do no smell as originally thought by many Canadians, and they enjoy people and attention. They eat a diet of seeds and grains, and drink water in moderation.

Gerbil excrement are small hard turds which are extremely easy to clean up. Since gerbils do not consume much water, they urinate relatively little as well. When they do, it is absorbed into the softness of their nests, which require changing once every month or so when their cages are cleaned.



The Human Sexuality Tax is a \$1.25 surcharge levied on sexual relations between consenting adults.

Why a tax on sex?

Because cigarettes and alcohol are already taxed to the hilt. Sex is the only central pleasure we haven't touched yet.

How do I pay the HST?

After relations you and your partner are each required to fill out a separate T69 Form and return it with a cheque for \$1.25 to Revenue and Taxation Canada. The forms are available At Post Offices, drug stores, and in the washrooms of many bars and dance clubs.

What if I don't, uh...get there?

The tax only applies if you achieve climax. So relax, go to it, when you wanna do it. Relax, when you wanna come.

What if I like little boys?

The HST only applies to consenting adults. Pedophiles and necrophiliacs are not required to pay the tax. Zoophiliacs and gerbil enthusiasts are also exempt.


What about safe sex?

Health and Welfare Canada advises the use of a condom to prevent sexually transmitted diseases. If you use a condom, you are eligible for an HST rebate equal to 40% of its cost. Retain the receipt and the used condom, and enclose both with your Federal Income Tax Return to receive the full rebate.

I'm from Quebec, do I pay more?

No, in fact you pay less. The HST is regionally adjusted to account for socio-cultural variation in the frequency of sexual relations. Persons from Etobicoke, for example, are required to pay an additional \$0.17 per encounter to make up for their lack of activity. Similarly, residents of Gaspé Bay may deduct \$0.76 from their payment.



Students Protest Non-Refundable Fee

About 6000 angry students demonstrated outside UNB President Robin Armstrong's residence yesterday to protest a \$25 fee the university is charging them for a health plan they do not get.

Last spring, the provincial government imposed a tuition-increase cap of five percent on New Brunswick universities. UNB chose to increase tuition for the 1993-94 by the full five percent.

In an unrelated development during this past year, the UNB Student Union will now be responsible for administering a student health plan instead of the university administration.

The fee for the administration's plan came out of student's tuition. It is valued at about \$25.

Next year, this hidden fee will still be charged, and students will now pay an extra \$100 to the Student Union for the new health plan.

"In these tight times, this non-refundable fee is the straw that broke the

camel's back," said VP External and protest organizer Huge McWheel. "The university must realize that students don't have the financial resources that high-paying administrative-types do."

Police Investigate Bizarre Theft

Freddy Beach City Police are investigating a bizarre robbery which left a male clerk completely bewildered, though unharmed.

According to investigating officer Sgt. Cop, the Irbing convenience store on the corner of Winkle and Gorge St.s was burglarized last evening at about 7:30 p.m.. A lone male, of about 35, entered the store wearing a mask and waving a molding twinkie. He proceeded to threaten the male clerk, with force-feeding. The twinkie, which the clerk assumed to be loaded, was of a dark brown colour, with chunky off-white icing and blue-green slime-mould.

The clerk, rendered defenseless by the odiferous snack cake, gave the thief the entire contents of the cash register, an amount totaling about \$487.38. The thief then proceeded to stuff the store's stork of Twinkies and DingDongs into a gym-bag, blue and red in color, and left the store. As he left, he is reported to have said, "They call me Joe Louis."

The city police and the RCMQ are investigating, and say the incident is in no way linked to a rash of thefts involving local produce stores.

No DisseyLand For Freddy Beach

City council last night rejected a bid from the multi-national Dissey corporation to build its newest Disseyland theme park on the former Tackers and Equipage lot on Smith Street.

Although the park would employ at least 3,000 workers during the peak season, the proposal was rejected largely because the ad package which promoted the proposed construction featured a large, human-size mouse.

Councillor Boredan' Peed explained in an interview yesterday that it was the opinion of council that the mouse did not foster the image that Freddy Beach hoped to garner for its community.

"There is a high percentage of Freddy Beach inhabitants who fear mice intensely. It's a very common phobia, and we don't want are city to be known as a municipality which inspires cardiac arrests in all of it's elderly population. We could literally scare then to death."

Peed also cited a recent study which concluded that children who had been exposed to oversized rodents in their formative years developed serious mental and physical ailments including hypothermia, megalomania, and foot in mouth disease.

"We aren't about to allow any-

thing into our city of stately elms which is going to jeopardise our citizens," Peed concluded.

The move has drawn wide criticism from Dissey representatives who were on-hand to defend their proposal at the council meeting.

Snow-White, a long-time upper management employee at Dissey, says she was surprised at the small-mindedness of the city councillors.

"Why I declare, I've come in contact with a lot of small people in my life, but this is ridiculous. At least my step-mother let me enjoy part of a yummy apple before she got mean. These folks played hard-ball right from the very beginning."

She said that she, and the seven other Dissey employees who accompanied her to Freddy Beach had no idea that they would encounter so much opposition. Meetings between Dissey officials and Freddy Beach Mayor Broad Woodpile had been very encouraging from the outset, and no hints of the ensuing bitter battle were given, she said.

"I guess there's not much left for us to do but go off to tell wizard." It is believed that the city council is especially sensitive about the large mouse issue since the discovery of two-tonne rodents at the University of New Bumslick this week (see page 2 for story).

Dills has been married for 15

years and lives with his wife Rita and their two children, five-year-old Costas, and six-year-old Gabrielle. They are very supportive of him and help him design new tricks in hiding from drivers' views.

"He is such and honest, caring person. He told me when we first met that he spent a lot of time chasing cars. And its a habit that doesn't harm the learning aptitude and social fabric of the family," said Mrs. Dills.

What kind of future will this unusual hobby give his children? "My childrens should grow up to be good runners, so I'll push them hard (into the traffic)."

"We love our dear dear Howard. He's such a wonderful husband, and he loves the children so," said Mrs. Dills.

In the meanwhile, Fredericton City Hall is in the midst of creating a new bylaw to make it a crime to chase cars.

"We don't want to see this type of thing reoccur. Someone could lose a limb," said one Councillor.


Bitchie and Runt both bolted for MacLavish upon hearing this to purchase the aforementioned skates to be just like their mentor.






