It is now a month since your railway contract was let, and yet the first ad has not been turned on it.

Although I felt sadly grieved, outraged and injured by the conduct of the Executive to me as one of the competitors for building and furnishing your projected Railway yet I did not deem it fitting to place my private grievances before the public eye.
