HE IS STILL IN THE TOLLS.

BUCKLEY MAY NOT GET THE BENEFIT OF THE LAW'S AMNISTY.

It is extremely probable that the brutal murderer, Thomas Buckley, will not receive the punishment which the amnesties characterise by his crime demands. Never before in the history of Ontario's criminal annals has there been such outspoken indication expressed at a public hearing that the man who committed the crime of the Buckley trial, public sentiment was a unit that the man should suffer the extreme penalty of the law, and where the law is so clearly against the offender, it is not surprising that it would be the most difficult punishment that the amnesties could bring to the murderer.

Yesterday morning Mr. Justice Irvine, Q.C., who is sitting for the Crown at the present time, gave notice in court that he would apply to-day to have the case resumed. He did this with a view of bringing before the court the prisoners' previous record, which fairly reads with lawlessness and violence. The following is the text of the notice which the Crown served on Buckley:

Thomas Buckley, charged with the murder of Mrs. Mary Jane Kelly, is a man of a very bad character. He has a long record of crime, including several years in the penitentiary for various offenses. His conduct during the trial was highly disrespectful and he has shown a complete disregard for the law. It is the duty of the court to ensure that justice is done and that the public interest is protected. Therefore, it is requested that the court grant the Crown's application for a continuance of the trial until such time as the necessary evidence can be presented.

The jury and the judge in "Tommy" Buckley's case are expected to return their verdict on the charge of manslaughter. The judge is expected to find the defendant guilty, but the jury may acquit on the charge of manslaughter. The case is expected to be concluded by the end of the week.

The first speaker was Mr. Newell Ridout, who moved the following resolution seconded by Mayor Ervin: "Resolved, that the amnesties be granted to all prisoners of war who have been held in captivity for more than two years." The resolution was carried by a large majority.

Mr. Ervin then spoke in support of the resolution and made an exhaustive speech in opposition to it. He pointed out the many difficulties that would be involved in the granting of amnesties and the potential harm to the public interest.

The meeting adjourned at a late hour. The speakers were well received and the audience was highly interested in the proceedings. The meeting was a success and it is expected that the amnesties will be granted in the near future.

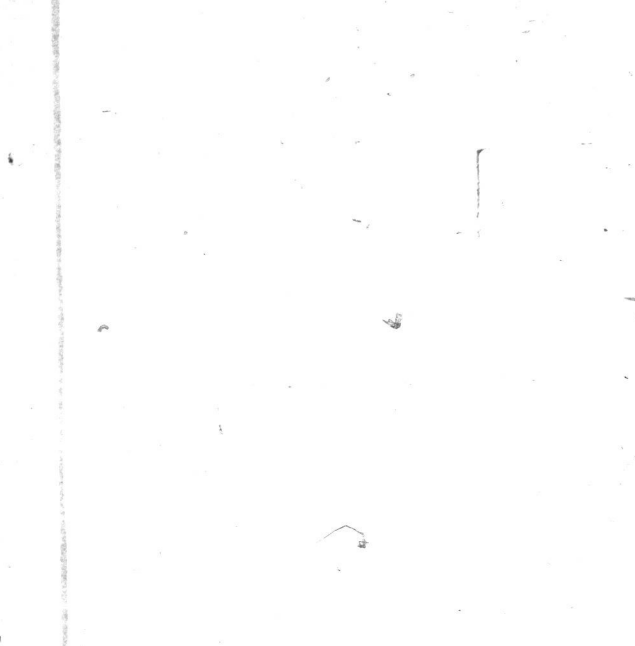
