WILL END HIS DAYS IN JAIL

A Life-Long Snake Thief, Now Sent Down for Ten Years.

Chief of Police at Kingston of St. Clark, alias W. Smith, one of the most noted snake thieves in the province ever had to deal with. When Clark came to Canada in 1878 he was 22 years of age. What his previous record was is unknown to the Canadian officers, but almost immediately on his arrival in Ontario, he was convicted of larceny and sent to the Central Prison for six months. His penchant for stealing the corridors of hotels and hallways of private residences has kept him in prison almost ever since. After his liberation from the Central he was unable to clear the city before his mania got him into trouble again, and he was sent back to Warden Massie's care for an additional five months. The expiration of this sentence he was again convicted, and this time was sent to Kingston for two years.

NO EPIDEMIC IN ONTARIO.

Diphtheria prevalent in only two localities in the Province. Reports have during the past few weeks appeared in several papers which give the impression that diphtheria is epidemic at several points in the Province. The health officers' department states that in only two localities has anything of the kind been reported. On Sept. 21 the officer at North Gosford, Essex, reported 20 cases in ten families. The children were spread over several adjoining townships. In 18 cases anti-toxin was used and only one child died. The disease is now rapidly disappearing.

September's Weather Record. During the latter days of September a remark was frequently made that this is the hottest September ever known. The observatory records show, however, that in British Columbia and the Northwest the temperature was 2 to 6 below the average, while in Ontario it was 1 to 2 above. In Nova Scotia it also went below the average. The lowest temperature of the month is reported at Brandon, where 12 degrees of frost were experienced. In Ontario Renwick, where the thermometer stood at 27 below zero, and at Toronto close to 30 below.

A large number of members of the Presbyterian Women's Foreign Missionary Society assembled at the Union Station at noon yesterday to bid farewell to Miss Jennie Dow, M.D., and Miss Maggie McIntosh, who left on the C.P.R. for Vancouver, B.C., on their way to Honan, China. At Vancouver the ladies will be joined by Dr. Menzies and the party will sail from that place on the 14th inst.
